## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1057

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "279A.025," insert "471.705,".
- On page 37, after line 9, insert:
- "SECTION 84a. ORS 471.705 is amended to read:
- 4 "471.705. (1) There is created the Oregon Liquor Control Commission,
- 5 consisting of [five persons] seven commissioners appointed by the Gover-
- 6 nor. One [member shall] commissioner must be from among the [bona
- 7 fide residents of each congressional district of [the] this state. One addi-
- 8 tional commissioner must be from eastern Oregon. One additional
- 9 commissioner must be from western Oregon. One [member shall] com-
- missioner must be from the food and alcoholic beverage retail industry.
- Not more than [three] four commissioners [shall] may be of the same poli-
- tical party [and one shall be designated by]. The Governor shall designate
- one commissioner to be chairperson of the commission. The commissioners
- are entitled to compensation and expenses as provided in ORS 292.495.
- "(2) Each commissioner at the time of appointment [and qualification]
- shall] must be a resident of this state and [shall] must have resided in this
- 17 state for at least five years next preceding appointment and qualification.
- 18 [The] Each commissioner [shall] must be an elector [therein] in this state
- and may not be less than 30 years of age. [A commissioner shall cease to hold
- 20 office] The term of office of a commissioner terminates if the commis-
- 21 sioner ceases to possess the residency or industry qualification for appoint-

ment [and]. If the term of office of a commissioner terminates under this subsection, the Governor shall appoint a qualified individual to complete the unexpired term of the commissioner.

"[(2)] (3) The term of office of a commissioner [shall be] is four years from 4 the time of appointment and qualification and until a successor qualifies for 5 **appointment**. The terms of the commissioners [shall] commence April 1. [In 6 case any If a commissioner is allowed to hold [over] office after the expi-7 ration of [the] a term, the [successor shall be appointed] Governor shall 8 **appoint the successor** for the [balance] **remainder** of the unexpired term. 9 [Vacancies in the commission shall be filled by the Governor for the unexpired 10 term.] If a vacancy occurs in the commission, the Governor shall ap-11 point the successor for the remainder of the unexpired term. Each 12 commissioner is eligible for reappointment, but [no person shall be] an in-13 dividual is not eligible to serve for more than two full terms. 14

"[(3)] (4) [All] Appointments of commissioners by the Governor **under this section** are subject to confirmation by the Senate pursuant to section 4, Article III, Oregon Constitution.".
