PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2834

- In line 2 of the printed bill, after "care" insert "; and declaring an emergency".
- Delete lines 4 through 16 and insert:
- 4 "SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:
- 5 "(a) 'Dentist' has the meaning given that term in ORS 679.010.
- 6 "(b) 'Physician' has the meaning given that term in ORS 677.010.
- 7 "(2) The Oregon Board of Dentistry, the Oregon Medical Board and
- 8 the Oregon State Board of Nursing shall, in collaboration, adopt uni-
- 9 form rules regarding the use of sedation services for in-office dental
- or medical procedures performed by health professionals licensed by
- 11 the boards.

- "(3) The rules adopted under subsection (2) of this section must restrict the administration of in-office sedation services:
- "(a) By a health professional other than a dentist or a physician described in paragraph (b) of this subsection, to patients classified as physical status 1 or physical status 2 by the American Society of
- 17 Anesthesiologists.
- 18 "(b) By dentists or physicians who have admitting privileges at a
- 19 health care facility in this state, to patients classified as physical sta-
- 20 tus 1, physical status 2 or physical status 3 by the American Society
- 21 of Anesthesiologists.

"SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2017 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2018.

"(2) The Oregon Board of Dentistry, the Oregon Medical Board and the Oregon State Board of Nursing may take any action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the boards to exercise, on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the boards by section 1 of this 2017 Act.

"SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage."
