**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2834**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “care” insert “; and declaring an emer-
2 gency”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 16 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

5 **“(a) ‘Dentist’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 679.010.**

6 **“(b) ‘Physician’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 677.010.**

7 **“(2) The Oregon Board of Dentistry, the Oregon Medical Board and**
8 **the Oregon State Board of Nursing shall, in collaboration, adopt uni-**
9 **form rules regarding the use of sedation services for in-office dental**
10 **or medical procedures performed by health professionals licensed by**
11 **the boards.**

12 **“(3) The rules adopted under subsection (2) of this section must**
13 **restrict the administration of in-office sedation services:**

14 **“(a) By a health professional other than a dentist or a physician**
15 **described in paragraph (b) of this subsection, to patients classified as**
16 **physical status 1 or physical status 2 by the American Society of**
17 **Anesthesiologists.**

18 **“(b) By dentists or physicians who have admitting privileges at a**
19 **health care facility in this state, to patients classified as physical sta-**
20 **tus 1, physical status 2 or physical status 3 by the American Society**
21 **of Anesthesiologists.**

1 **“SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2017 Act becomes operative on**
2 **January 1, 2018.**

3 **“(2) The Oregon Board of Dentistry, the Oregon Medical Board and**
4 **the Oregon State Board of Nursing may take any action before the**
5 **operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is neces-**
6 **sary to enable the boards to exercise, on and after the operative date**
7 **specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions**
8 **and powers conferred on the boards by section 1 of this 2017 Act.**

9 **“SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate**
10 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
11 **declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**
