**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 3352**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the  
2 rest of the line and line 3 and insert “and declaring an emergency.”.

3 Delete lines 5 through 26 and delete pages 2 through 6 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority in collaboration with**  
5 **the Department of Education shall conduct an evaluation related to**  
6 **behavioral health services provided to public school students in**  
7 **kindergarten through grade 12 in this state. The evaluation shall**  
8 **identify:**

9 **“(a) The current level of behavioral health services being provided,**  
10 **including:**

11 **“(A) Barriers and challenges to providing behavioral health ser-**  
12 **vices; and**

13 **“(B) Gaps in behavioral health services that are being provided and**  
14 **resources that are available for behavioral health services.**

15 **“(b) How information collected under paragraph (a) of this sub-**  
16 **section shall be incorporated into five-year plans of coordinated care**  
17 **organizations, including how the information will be used to:**

18 **“(A) Develop common measurements of success and best practices**  
19 **for the purposes of achieving, at a minimum, the following:**

20 **“(i) An increase in mental health referrals and treatments between**  
21 **schools and community-based behavioral health professionals;**

1       “(ii) A decrease in expulsions for students with behavioral health  
2 needs; and

3       “(iii) A decrease in chronic absenteeism for students with behav-  
4 ioral health needs.

5       “(B) Develop a local system of behavioral health services that is  
6 based on a shared set of principles, common measurements of success  
7 and best practices for providing direct classroom support for students  
8 and teachers to ensure the highest opportunity of educational success  
9 for students with behavioral health needs.

10       “(C) Increase the collaboration between coordinated care organiza-  
11 tions and school districts.

12       “(2) For the purpose of collecting information and identifying data  
13 elements and methodology, the authority shall collaborate with rep-  
14 resentatives of:

15       “(a) A state-based association that represents school administra-  
16 tors; and

17       “(b) State-based coordinated care organizations.

18       “(3) The authority shall submit a report on the evaluation described  
19 in subsections (1) and (2) of this section to the interim committees of  
20 the Legislative Assembly related to education or health care no later  
21 than December 30, 2017.

22       “SECTION 2. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate  
23 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is  
24 declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage.”.
