**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3391**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 6, after “means” insert “health care”
2 and after “or” insert “medical”.

3 In line 16, after “care” delete the rest of the line and insert “prescribed
4 by the Department of Consumer and Business Services by rule consistent
5 with guidelines published by the United States Health Resources and Ser-
6 vices Administration.”.

7 On page 2, line 31, delete “provide coverage without a prescription for”
8 and insert “pay pharmacy claims for reimbursement of”.

9 In line 34, after “contraception” insert “method”.

10 In line 35, after “for” insert “medically appropriate”.

11 Delete lines 39 through 45 and insert:

12 “(L) As a single claim or combined with other claims for covered services
13 provided on the same day:

14 “(A) Patient education and counseling on contraception and sterilization.

15 “(B) Services related to sterilization or the administration and monitoring
16 of contraceptive drugs, devices and products, including but not limited to:

17 “(i) Management of side effects;

18 “(ii) Counseling for continued adherence to a prescribed regimen;

19 “(iii) Device insertion and removal; and

20 “(iv) Provision of alternative contraceptive drugs, devices or products
21 deemed medically appropriate in the judgment of the enrollee’s provider.”.

1 On page 3, delete line 1.

2 In line 2, delete “(n)” and insert “(m)”.

3 In line 31, after “rule” insert “consistent with the requirements for pro-
4 vider networks in ORS 743B.505”.

5 In line 37, delete “or” and insert “and”.

6 On page 4, after line 3, insert:

7 “(12) This section does not prohibit an insurer from using reasonable
8 medical management techniques to determine the frequency, method, treat-
9 ment or setting for the coverage of services, drugs, devices, products and
10 procedures described in subsection (2) of this section, other than coverage
11 required by subsection (2)(g) and (j) of this section, if the techniques:

12 “(a) Are consistent with the coverage requirements of subsection (2) of
13 this section; and

14 “(b) Do not result in the wholesale or indiscriminate denial of coverage
15 for a service.”.

16 In line 41, delete “female” and insert “individual” and delete “her” and
17 insert “the individual’s”.

18 In line 43, delete “female” and insert “individual” and delete “her” and
19 insert “the individual’s”.

20 On page 5, after line 5, insert:

21 **“SECTION 9. The Health Evidence Review Commission shall review
22 the coverage described in section 2 (2) of this 2017 Act and, no later
23 than November 1 of each even-numbered year, report to the interim
24 committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health any recom-
25 mended changes to the coverage described in section 2 (2) of this 2017
26 Act based upon the latest clinical research.”.**

27 In line 6, delete “9” and insert “10”.

28 In line 10, delete “10” and insert “11”.

29 In line 12, delete “11” and insert “12” and delete “Section 5 of this 2017
30 Act becomes” and insert “Sections 5 and 9 of this 2017 Act become”.

1 In line 14, delete “section 5” and insert “sections 5 and 9”.

2 In line 16, delete “12” and insert “13”.
