**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 872**

1 On page 3 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 35 and 36 and in-  
2 sert:

3 “(14)(a) ‘State agency’ means every state officer, board, commission, de-  
4 partment, institution, branch or agency of the state government, except:

5 “(A) The Secretary of State;

6 “(B) The State Treasurer;

7 “(C) The Oregon State Lottery; and

8 “(D) A public university that is listed in ORS 352.002.”.

9 On page 7, delete lines 10 through 16 and insert:

10 **“SECTION 4.** (1)(a) The Department of Information Technology shall  
11 oversee and coordinate planning, budgeting, architecture and standardi-  
12 zation, consolidation, acquisition and oversight of all information and tele-  
13 communications technology for the executive department to address  
14 statewide and individual agencies’ plans and activities in the most inte-  
15 grated, economic and efficient manner, in a manner that minimizes dupli-  
16 cation, fragmentation, redundancy and cost in executive department  
17 operations and in a manner that most effectively meets executive department  
18 and state agency program needs.”.

19 Delete lines 41 through 45 and insert:

20 “(a) Adopt rules, policies and standards to plan for, develop architecture  
21 for and standardize information resources and technologies within the exec-

1 utive department. In developing rules, policies and standards, the State Chief  
2 Information Officer shall consult with state agencies that have needs that  
3 information resources can satisfy. State agencies shall cooperate with the  
4 State Chief Information Officer and the Department of Information Tech-  
5 nology in preparing and complying with rules, policies and standards that  
6 the State Chief Information Officer adopts.”.

7 On page 8, delete line 1.

8 On page 30, line 44, delete “contracting”.
