PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 897

1 Delete lines 4 through 16 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) A person commits the crime of militia terrorism
if the person, together with at least nine other persons, physically
occupies publicly owned premises and the person has knowledge of the
following circumstances:

"(a) A law enforcement officer or a person in charge of the premises
informs at least one of the occupying persons that all occupying persons must leave the premises;

9 "(b) At least one of the occupying persons remains on the premises
10 for more than 48 hours following the direction to leave;

"(c) At least two of the occupying persons possess a firearm while
 physically occupying the premises; and

"(d) At least one of the occupying persons brandishes or openly
 displays a firearm while physically occupying the premises.

15 **"(2) Militia terrorism is a Class C felony.**

16 "(3) As used in this section:

17 "(a) 'Firearm' has the meaning given that term in ORS 166.210.

"(b) 'Person in charge' has the meaning given that term in ORS
19 164.205.

20 "(c) 'Premises' means any building and any real property.".
