**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2321**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 6 through 25.

2 On page 2, delete lines 1 and 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section,**  
4 **after leaving the waters of this state with a boat, a person shall re-**  
5 **move or open all drain plugs, bailers, valves or other devices used to**  
6 **control the draining of water from ballast tanks, bilges, livewells and**  
7 **motorwells before transporting a boat within this state.**

8 **“(2) Subsection (1) of this section does not apply to:**

9 **“(a) Marine sanitary systems;**

10 **“(b) Boats operated by peace officers; or**

11 **“(c) Boats operated by emergency responders, as defined by the**  
12 **State Marine Board by rule.**

13 **“SECTION 3. ORS 830.565 is amended to read:**

14 **“830.565. (1) A person may not operate a [*manually propelled boat that is***  
15 ***10 feet or more in length or a*] motorboat on the waters of this state without**  
16 **first obtaining an aquatic invasive species prevention permit from the State**  
17 **Marine Board under ORS 830.570.**

18 **“(2) A person 16 years of age or older may not operate a nonmo-**  
19 **torized boat that is nine feet or more in length on the waters of this**  
20 **state without first obtaining an aquatic invasive species prevention**  
21 **permit from the board under ORS 830.570.**

1        “[2] (3) A person who obtains an aquatic invasive species prevention  
2 permit for a [*manually propelled*] **nonmotorized** boat may use the permit on  
3 any [*manually propelled*] **nonmotorized** boat the person operates on the  
4 waters of this state.”.
