- In line 2 of the printed bill, after the semicolon insert "creating new
- 2 provisions; amending ORS 390.124; and prescribing an effective date.".
- Delete lines 22 through 26 and insert:
- 4 "(3) If the commission adopts rules that allow a person to make reserva-
- 5 tions for the use of campsites established and maintained by the department,
- 6 the rules shall require the department to identify and set aside 10 percent
- 7 of the campsites available at each state park where campsite reservations
- 8 are permitted, or four campsites, whichever is more, to be available only for
- 9 reservation, upon the showing of proper identification, by a disabled veteran.
- 10 The restriction on reservations under this subsection shall apply only during
- the first 30 days of any applicable reservation period.".
- 12 After line 28, insert:
- "SECTION 2. On or before February 15, 2018, the State Parks and
- 14 Recreation Department shall report to the Senate Committee on Vet-
- erans and Emergency Preparedness in the manner provided in ORS
- 16 192.245 on implementation of the amendments to ORS 390.124 by sec-
- 17 tion 1 of this 2017 Act.
- "SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2,
- 19 **2019.**
- 20 "SECTION 4. (1) The amendments to ORS 390.124 by section 1 of this
- 21 **2017** Act become operative January 1, 2018.

"(2) The State Parks and Recreation Commission and the State 1 Parks and Recreation Department may take any action before the op-2 erative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary 3 to enable the commission and the department to exercise, on and after 4 the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the 5 duties, functions and powers conferred on the commission and the 6 department by the amendments to ORS 390.124 by section 1 of this 2017 7 Act. 8

"SECTION 5. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2017 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.".
