Nothing in section 2 of this 2017 Act:

"(1) Restricts the rights of a financial institution to take or refuse
to take any action pursuant to the financial institution's deposit or
other contract with the financial institution's customer; or

"(2) Requires a financial institution to comply with any provision
 of section 2 of this 2017 Act when acting pursuant to the provisions
 of the financial institution's deposit or other contract with the finan cial institution's customer.

"<u>SECTION 4.</u> Sections 2 and 3 of this 2017 Act become operative on
 October 1, 2017.

"SECTION 5. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate
 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
 declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage.".
