**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3211**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “lands” insert “; and prescribing an ef-
2 fective date”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 6 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on Industrially Zoned Lands is**
5 **established.**

6 **“(2) The task force consists of seven members appointed as follows:**

7 **“(a) The President of the Senate shall appoint one member from**
8 **among members of the Senate.**

9 **“(b) The Senate Minority Leader shall appoint one member from**
10 **among members of the Senate.**

11 **“(c) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint one**
12 **member from among members of the House of Representatives.**

13 **“(d) The House Minority Leader shall appoint one member from**
14 **among members of the House of Representatives.**

15 **“(e) The Director of the Oregon Business Development Department**
16 **shall appoint three members with expertise in the development of in-**
17 **dustrially zoned lands.**

18 **“(3) The task force shall study barriers to the development of in-**
19 **dustrially zoned lands in Oregon.**

20 **“(4) A majority of the voting members of the task force constitutes**
21 **a quorum for the transaction of business.**

1 **“(5) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a**
2 **majority of the voting members of the task force.**

3 **“(6) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as**
4 **chairperson.**

5 **“(7) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority**
6 **shall make an appointment to become immediately effective.**

7 **“(8) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the**
8 **call of the chairperson or of a majority of the voting members of the**
9 **task force.**

10 **“(9) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of**
11 **the task force.**

12 **“(10) The task force shall submit a report in the manner provided**
13 **by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to**
14 **an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to economic**
15 **development no later than September 15, 2018.**

16 **“(11) The Oregon Business Development Department shall provide**
17 **staff support to the task force.**

18 **“(12) Members of the Legislative Assembly appointed to the task**
19 **force are nonvoting members of the task force and may act in an ad-**
20 **visory capacity only.**

21 **“(13) Members of the task force who are not members of the Leg-**
22 **islative Assembly are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement**
23 **for expenses and serve as volunteers on the task force.**

24 **“(14) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111,**
25 **are directed to assist the task force in the performance of the task**
26 **force’s duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to**
27 **confidentiality, to furnish information and advice the members of the**
28 **task force consider necessary to perform their duties.**

29 **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on December 31,**
30 **2018.**
