**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3355**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 25, delete “seven” and insert “nine”.

2 Delete lines 27 through 29.

3 On page 2, delete lines 1 and 2 and insert:

4 “(a) The State Board of Psychologist Examiners shall appoint:

5 “(A) Three licensed psychologists, one of whom is a member of the State
6 Board of Psychologist Examiners and one of whom has completed the clinical
7 residency program described in section 4 of this 2017 Act; and

8 “(B) One member of the public who is a consumer of the services provided
9 by a licensed psychologist.

10 “(b) The Oregon Medical Board shall appoint four prescribing physicians,
11 at least one of whom is a psychiatrist, one of whom practices as a primary
12 care physician and one of whom has expertise in the treatment of children.

13 “(c) The State Board of Pharmacy shall appoint one pharmacist licensed
14 under ORS chapter 689 who has expertise in psychotropic medications.”.

15 Delete lines 9 through 40 and insert:

16 “(3) The members of the committee shall elect one of the licensed psy-
17 chologists appointed under subsection (1)(a) of this section as the chair-
18 person of the committee.

19 “(4) The committee shall:

20 “(a) Review and make recommendations to the State Board of Psychol-
21 ogist Examiners on clinical residency programs proposed by applicants

1 seeking a conditional certificate of prescriptive authority;

2 “(b) Review and make recommendations to the State Board of Psychol-
3 ogist Examiners on applications submitted for certificates of prescriptive
4 authority;

5 “(c) Develop and make recommendations to the State Board of Psychol-
6 ogist Examiners regarding the formulary and make recommendations for an-
7 nual revisions of the formulary;

8 “(d) Develop and make recommendations to the State Board of Psychol-
9 ogist Examiners regarding standards, examinations and continuing education
10 for prescribing psychologists; and

11 “(e) Report to the State Board of Psychologist Examiners regarding the
12 use of prescriptive authority by prescribing psychologists.

13 “(5) A majority of the members of the committee constitutes a quorum for
14 the transaction of business.

15 “(6) Official action by the committee requires the approval of a majority
16 of the members of the committee.

17 “(7) The committee may seek the assistance of a neutral third party in
18 resolving disagreements among the committee members and facilitating the
19 collaborative process.

20 “(8) The committee shall meet at times and places specified by the call
21 of the chairperson or a majority of the members of the committee.

22 “(9) The committee may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the
23 committee.

24 “(10) The State Board of Psychologist Examiners shall provide staff sup-
25 port to the committee.

26 “(11) Members of the committee are not entitled to compensation, but may
27 be reimbursed from funds available to the State Board of Psychologist Ex-
28 aminers for actual and necessary travel and other expenses incurred by
29 committee members in the performance of their official duties in the manner
30 and amount provided in ORS 292.495.”
