[(1) An applicant for a license to practice respiratory care shall:] 3 The Health Licensing Office may issue a license to practice respiratory 4 care to an applicant who: 5 "[(a)] (1) [Submit] Submits to the [Health Licensing] office written evi-6 dence that the applicant: 7 "[(A)] (a) Is at least 18 years of age; 8 "[(B)] (b) Has completed an approved four-year high school course of 9 study or the equivalent as determined by the appropriate educational agency; 10 and 11 12 "[(C)] (c) [Has completed a respiratory care education program approved by the American Medical Association in collaboration with the Joint Review 13 Committee for Respiratory Therapy Education or their successors or equivalent 14 organizations, as approved by the Respiratory Therapist and Polysomno-15 graphic Technologist Licensing Board; and] Holds an active credential 16 conferred by the National Board for Respiratory Care, or its successor 17 organization, as a Registered Respiratory Therapist; and 18

"[(b)] (2) [Pass an examination] Passes any examinations approved by

the Respiratory Therapist and Polysomnographic Technologist Licens-

ing Board, including but not limited to an examination regarding

Oregon law and administrative rules related to the practice of respiratory care.

- "[(2) An applicant meets the requirements of subsection (1)(a)(C) of this section if the applicant provides the office with documentation of military training or experience that the board determines is substantially equivalent to the education required by subsection (1)(a)(C) of this section.]
- "[(3) The office may issue a license to practice respiratory care by endorsement or reciprocity to:]
- "[(a) An applicant who is currently licensed to practice respiratory care
 under the laws of another state, territory or country if the qualifications of the
 applicant are considered by the office to be equivalent to those required in this
 state; or]
- "[(b) An applicant holding an active credential conferred by the National Board for Respiratory Care as a Certified Respiratory Therapist (CRT) or as a Registered Respiratory Therapist (RRT), or both.]".

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
