PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2503

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "professionals;" delete the rest
- 2 of the line and line 3 and insert "and prescribing an effective date.".
- Delete lines 5 through 28 and delete pages 2 through 6 and insert:
- "SECTION 1. The Health Licensing Office shall register as a lactation services provider a person who:
- 6 "(1) Submits to the office sufficient proof, as determined by the office, that the person holds a current certification:
- "(a) As a Certified Lactation Counselor from the Academy of Lactation Policy and Practice, or its successor organization, that is approved by the office;
- "(b) As an International Board Certified Lactation Consultant from the International Board of Lactation Consultant Examiners, or its successor organization, that is approved by the office;
- "(c) From a certification program accredited by the American National Standards Institute, or its successor organization, that is approved by the office; or
- "(d) From a certification program accredited by the National Commission for Certifying Agencies, or its successor organization, that is approved by the office; and
- 20 "(2) Pays a fee, as determined by the office by rule.

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"SECTION 2. Section 3 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part

of ORS chapter 414.

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- "SECTION 3. The services provided to a medical assistance recipient by a lactation services provider registered by the Health Licensing Office must be reimbursed by the Oregon Health Authority at a rate
- 5 determined by the authority.
- "SECTION 4. The requirements of section 3 of this 2017 Act apply to services provided on or after the operative date specified in section 5 of this 2017 Act.
- 9 "SECTION 5. (1) Sections 1 to 3 of this 2017 Act become operative on January 1, 2018.
 - "(2) The Health Licensing Office and the Oregon Health Authority may take any action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the office and the authority to exercise, on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the office and the authority by sections 1 to 3 of this 2017 Act.
 - "SECTION 6. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2017 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.".

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
