**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2503**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “professionals;” delete the rest
2 of the line and line 3 and insert “and prescribing an effective date.”

3 Delete lines 5 through 28 and delete pages 2 through 6 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. The Health Licensing Office shall register as a
5 lactation services provider a person who:**

6 **“(1) Submits to the office sufficient proof, as determined by the of-
7 fice, that the person holds a current certification:**

8 **“(a) As a Certified Lactation Counselor from the Academy of
9 Lactation Policy and Practice, or its successor organization, that is
10 approved by the office;**

11 **“(b) As an International Board Certified Lactation Consultant from
12 the International Board of Lactation Consultant Examiners, or its
13 successor organization, that is approved by the office;**

14 **“(c) From a certification program accredited by the American Na-
15 tional Standards Institute, or its successor organization, that is ap-
16 proved by the office; or**

17 **“(d) From a certification program accredited by the National Com-
18 mission for Certifying Agencies, or its successor organization, that is
19 approved by the office; and**

20 **“(2) Pays a fee, as determined by the office by rule.**

21 **“SECTION 2. Section 3 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part**

1 of ORS chapter 414.

2 **“SECTION 3. The services provided to a medical assistance recipient**
3 **by a lactation services provider registered by the Health Licensing**
4 **Office must be reimbursed by the Oregon Health Authority at a rate**
5 **determined by the authority.**

6 **“SECTION 4. The requirements of section 3 of this 2017 Act apply**
7 **to services provided on or after the operative date specified in section**
8 **5 of this 2017 Act.**

9 **“SECTION 5. (1) Sections 1 to 3 of this 2017 Act become operative**
10 **on January 1, 2018.**

11 **“(2) The Health Licensing Office and the Oregon Health Authority**
12 **may take any action before the operative date specified in subsection**
13 **(1) of this section that is necessary to enable the office and the au-**
14 **thority to exercise, on and after the operative date specified in sub-**
15 **section (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions and powers**
16 **conferred on the office and the authority by sections 1 to 3 of this 2017**
17 **Act.**

18 **“SECTION 6. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the**
19 **date on which the 2017 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative**
20 **Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**

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
