PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 871

1	On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "demolitions" insert a period
2	and delete the rest of the line and line 3.

- Delete lines 5 through 28 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:
- "SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 455.
- "SECTION 2. The Department of Consumer and Business Services shall amend the state building code as necessary to create standards and guidelines for the demolition of residences or residential buildings that may contain asbestos or lead-based paint. In adopting the standards and guidelines, the department shall:
 - "(1) Exempt those residences and residential buildings that were constructed on or after a date on which the use of asbestos or leadbased paint was discontinued from the provisions of this section;
 - "(2) Require notice of the demolition to be provided to the individuals living in the immediate neighborhood;
- "(3) At a minimum, require the demolition to be in accordance with ORS 654.001 to 654.295, 654.412 to 654.423 and 654.750 to 654.780 and any federal law or regulation setting forth occupational safety and health standards; and
- 20 "(4) Require the demolition to be in accordance with any other 21 standard established by the department.".
