**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2321**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 6 through 25.

2 On page 2, delete lines 1 and 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section,**
4 **after leaving the waters of this state with a boat, a person shall re-**
5 **move or open all drain plugs, bailers, valves or other devices used to**
6 **control the draining of water from ballast tanks, bilges, livewells and**
7 **motorwells before transporting a boat within this state.**

8 **“(2) Subsection (1) of this section does not apply to:**

9 **“(a) Marine sanitary systems;**

10 **“(b) Boats operated by peace officers; or**

11 **“(c) Boats operated by emergency responders, as defined by the**
12 **State Marine Board by rule.**

13 **“SECTION 3. ORS 830.565 is amended to read:**

14 **“830.565. (1) A person may not operate a [*manually propelled*] nonmo-**
15 **torized boat that is 10 feet or more in length or a motorboat on the waters**
16 **of this state without first obtaining an aquatic invasive species prevention**
17 **permit from the State Marine Board under ORS 830.570.**

18 **“(2) A person who obtains an aquatic invasive species prevention permit**
19 **for a [*manually propelled*] nonmotorized boat may use the permit on any**
20 **[*manually propelled*] nonmotorized boat the person operates on the waters**
21 **of this state.”.**
