**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3047**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, before “837.365” insert “837.340 and”.

2 Delete line 12.

3 In line 13, delete “(b)” and insert “(a)”.

4 Delete lines 15 through 17 and insert:

5 “(b) The person notifies the Oregon Department of Aviation, the Oregon
6 State Police and any other agency that issues a permit or license for the
7 activity requiring the use of the unmanned aircraft system that the person
8 intends to use an unmanned aircraft system that is capable of firing a bullet
9 or projectile at least five days before the person uses the system; and”.

10 In line 18, delete “(d)” and insert “(c)”.

11 In line 19, after “a” insert “bullet or”.

12 After line 19, insert:

13 “(3) The notification requirement of subsection (2)(b) of this section does
14 not apply to:

15 “(a) A career school licensed under ORS 345.010 to 345.450;

16 “(b) A community college as defined in ORS 341.005;

17 “(c) An education service district as defined in ORS 334.003;

18 “(d) The Oregon Health and Science University;

19 “(e) A public high school;

20 “(f) A public university listed in ORS 352.002; or

21 “(g) An institution that is exempt from ORS 348.594 to 348.615 under ORS

1 348.597 (2).”.

2 In line 20, delete “(3)” and insert “(4)”.

3 In line 21, after “a” insert “bullet or”.

4 After line 21, insert:

5 **“SECTION 2.** ORS 837.340 is amended to read:

6 “837.340. (1) A law enforcement agency may operate an unmanned aircraft
7 system, acquire information through the operation of an unmanned aircraft
8 system, or disclose information acquired through the operation of an un-
9 manned aircraft system, for the purpose of reconstruction of a specific crime
10 scene **or accident scene**, or similar physical assessment, related to a specific
11 [*criminal*] investigation.

12 “(2) The period that a law enforcement agency may operate an unmanned
13 aircraft system under this section may not exceed five days for the purpose
14 of reconstruction of a specific crime scene **or accident scene**, or similar
15 physical assessment, related to a specific [*criminal*] investigation.”.
