**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2238**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “137.656” delete the rest of the
2 line and delete lines 3 and 4 and insert “and 251.185 and sections 1, 3 and
3 5, chapter 600, Oregon Laws 2013; repealing section 10, chapter 600, Oregon
4 Laws 2013; and declaring an emergency.”.

5 Delete lines 6 through 22 and delete pages 2 and 3.

6 On page 4, delete lines 1 through 38.

7 In line 39, delete “9” and insert “1”.

8 On page 5, line 43, delete “10” and insert “2”.

9 On page 6, delete lines 1 through 3 and insert:

10 “(2)(a) Upon written request from a member of the Legislative Assembly
11 from each major political party, the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission
12 shall prepare a racial and ethnic impact statement on proposed legislation
13 that is related to crime and likely to have an effect on the criminal justice
14 system.”.

15 In line 18, delete “11” and insert “3” and after the period delete the rest
16 of the line and delete lines 19 and 20 and insert “(1)(a) Upon written request
17 from a member of the Legislative Assembly from each major political party,
18 the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall prepare a racial and ethnic
19 impact statement for a state measure that is related to crime and likely to
20 have an effect on the criminal justice system.”.

21 In line 23, delete “10” and insert “2”.

1 In line 24, delete “10” and insert “2”.

2 In line 45, delete “12” and insert “4”.

3 On page 7, line 23, delete “13” and insert “5”.

4 On page 8, line 6, delete “14” and insert “6”.

5 In line 7, delete “15” and insert “7”.

6 Delete lines 34 through 37 and insert:

7 “(e) To prepare the racial and ethnic impact statements described in
8 sections 2 and 3 of this 2017 Act.”.

9 On page 9, delete lines 2 through 45 and delete page 10 and insert:

10 **“SECTION 8.** ORS 251.185, as amended by section 8, chapter 600, Oregon
11 Laws 2013, and section 5, chapter 72, Oregon Laws 2014, is amended to read:

12 “251.185. (1) The Secretary of State shall have printed in the voters’
13 pamphlet for a general election or any special election a copy of the title
14 and text of each state measure to be submitted to the people at the election
15 for which the pamphlet was prepared. The pamphlet must include the proce-
16 dures for filing a complaint under ORS 260.345. Each measure shall be
17 printed in the pamphlet with:

18 “(a) The number and ballot title of the measure;

19 “(b) The financial estimates and any statement prepared for the measure
20 under ORS 250.125;

21 “(c) The explanatory statement prepared for the measure;

22 “(d) Arguments relating to the measure and filed with the Secretary of
23 State; *[and]*

24 **“(e) Any racial and ethnic impact statement prepared for the
25 measure under section 3, chapter 600, Oregon Laws 2013, or section 3
26 of this 2017 Act; and**

27 “[*e*] (f) Any statement submitted for the measure by a citizen panel un-
28 der ORS 250.141.

29 “(2) A county measure or measure of a metropolitan service district or-
30 ganized under ORS chapter 268, and ballot title, explanatory statement and

1 arguments relating to the measure, filed by the county or metropolitan ser-
2 vice district under ORS 251.285 shall be included in the voters' pamphlet
3 described in subsection (1) of this section if required under ORS 251.067.

4 **SECTION 9.** ORS 251.185, as amended by section 8, chapter 600, Oregon
5 Laws 2013, section 5, chapter 72, Oregon Laws 2014, and section 8 of this 2017
6 Act, is amended to read:

7 "251.185. (1) The Secretary of State shall have printed in the voters'
8 pamphlet for a general election or any special election a copy of the title
9 and text of each state measure to be submitted to the people at the election
10 for which the pamphlet was prepared. The pamphlet must include the proce-
11 dures for filing a complaint under ORS 260.345. Each measure shall be
12 printed in the pamphlet with:

13 "(a) The number and ballot title of the measure;

14 "(b) The financial estimates and any statement prepared for the measure
15 under ORS 250.125;

16 "(c) The explanatory statement prepared for the measure;

17 "(d) Arguments relating to the measure and filed with the Secretary of
18 State;

19 "(e) Any racial and ethnic impact statement prepared for the measure
20 under [*section 3, chapter 600, Oregon Laws 2013, or*] section 3 of this 2017
21 Act; and

22 "(f) Any statement submitted for the measure by a citizen panel under
23 ORS 250.141.

24 "(2) A county measure or measure of a metropolitan service district or-
25 ganized under ORS chapter 268, and ballot title, explanatory statement and
26 arguments relating to the measure, filed by the county or metropolitan ser-
27 vice district under ORS 251.285 shall be included in the voters' pamphlet
28 described in subsection (1) of this section if required under ORS 251.067.

29 **SECTION 10.** **Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on the date of**
30 **the convening of the 2023 regular session of the Legislative Assembly**

1 as specified in ORS 171.010.

2 **“SECTION 11.** Section 5, chapter 600, Oregon Laws 2013, is amended to
3 read:

4 **“Sec. 5. (1)** [*Sections 1 to 4 of this 2013 Act*] **Sections 2 and 4, chapter**
5 **600, Oregon Laws 2013,** are repealed on January 2, 2018.

6 **“(2)** **Sections 1 and 3, chapter 600, Oregon Laws 2013, as amended**
7 **by sections 4 and 5 of this 2017 Act, are repealed on January 2, 2018.**

8 **“SECTION 12.** The amendments to ORS 251.185 by section 9 of this
9 **2017 Act become operative on January 2, 2018.**

10 **“SECTION 13.** Section 3 of this 2017 Act and the amendments to
11 **ORS 251.185 by section 9 of this 2017 Act apply to elections held on or**
12 **after the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November 2018.**

13 **“SECTION 14.** This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate
14 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
15 **declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**

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
