**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 357**

1 Delete lines 4 through 23 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 166.116 is amended to read:

3 “166.116. (1) A person commits the crime of interfering with public
4 transportation if the person:

5 “(a) Intentionally or knowingly enters or remains unlawfully in or on a
6 public transit vehicle or public transit station;

7 “(b) Intentionally or knowingly interferes with the provision or use of
8 public transportation services by, among other things, interfering with the
9 movement of, or access to, public transit vehicles;

10 “(c) While in or on a public transit vehicle or public transit station, en-
11 gages in disorderly conduct in the second degree as defined in ORS 166.025;
12 or

13 “(d) Subjects a public transportation passenger, employee, agent or secu-
14 rity officer or transit police officer to offensive physical contact.

15 “[*(2) Interfering with public transportation is a Class A misdemeanor.*]

16 **“(2)(a)(A) Interfering with public transportation as provided in
17 subsection (1)(a) of this section is a Class C misdemeanor.**

18 **“(B) Notwithstanding subparagraph (A) of this paragraph, interfer-
19 ing with public transportation as provided in subsection (1)(a) of this
20 section is a Class A misdemeanor if the person has three or more prior
21 convictions for interfering with public transportation as provided in**

1 **subsection (1)(a) of this section.**

2 **“(b) Interfering with public transportation as provided in subsection**
3 **(1)(b) to (d) of this section is a Class A misdemeanor.**

4 “(3) As used in this section:

5 “(a) ‘Enter or remain unlawfully’ has the meaning given that term in ORS
6 164.205.

7 “(b) ‘Public transit station’ includes all facilities, structures, lands and
8 rights of way that are owned, leased, held or used for the purposes of pro-
9 viding public transportation services.

10 “(c) ‘Public transit vehicle’ means a vehicle that is used for public
11 transportation or operated by or under contract to any public body in order
12 to provide public transportation.

13 “(d) ‘Public transportation’ means transportation provided by a city,
14 county, special district or any other political subdivision or municipal or
15 public corporation.”.
