PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2593

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 7 through 30 and insert:

<u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) In any criminal proceeding, property or material
that constitutes a visual depiction of a child engaged in sexually explicit conduct must remain in the care, custody and control of either
a law enforcement agency or the court.

6 "(2) Notwithstanding any request by the defendant, any property 7 or material that constitutes a visual depiction of a child engaged in 8 sexually explicit conduct may not be copied, photographed, duplicated 9 or otherwise reproduced, so long as the property or material is made 10 reasonably available to the defendant.

11 "(3) As used in this section:

12 "(a) 'Child' has the meaning given that term in ORS 163.665.

"(b) 'Law enforcement agency' means any agency that employs po lice officers or prosecutes criminal cases.

15 "(c) 'Reasonably available' means that the state has provided the 16 defendant, the defendant's attorney and any individual the defendant 17 may seek to qualify to furnish expert testimony at trial, ample op-18 portunity to inspect, view and examine the property or material at a 19 law enforcement agency facility.

"(d) 'Sexually explicit conduct' has the meaning given that term in
 ORS 163.665.

"(e) 'Visual depiction' has the meaning given that term in ORS
163.665.".
