**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 1057**

1 On page 15 of the printed bill, after line 39, insert:

3 **“TASK FORCE ON CONSOLIDATION**

4
5 **“SECTION 36c. (1) The Task Force on the Consolidation of Regula-**
6 **tory Marijuana Programs is established.**

7 **“(2) The task force consists of 16 members appointed as follows:**

8 **“(a) The President of the Senate shall appoint two nonvoting**
9 **members from among members of the Senate, one from among the**
10 **members of the Senate who belong to the majority party and one from**
11 **among the members of the Senate who belong to the minority party.**

12 **“(b) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint two**
13 **nonvoting members from among members of the House of Represen-**
14 **tatives, one from among the members of the House of Representatives**
15 **who belong to the majority party and one from among the members**
16 **of the House of Representatives who belong to the minority party.**

17 **“(c) The Governor shall appoint:**

18 **“(A) One person from the Oregon Liquor Control Commission;**

19 **“(B) One person from the Oregon Health Authority;**

20 **“(C) One person from the State Department of Agriculture;**

21 **“(D) One person from the Department of Revenue;**

- 1 **“(E) One person from the Attorney General’s office;**
- 2 **“(F) Two persons who represent or who are licensees under ORS**
3 **475B.010 to 475B.395;**
- 4 **“(G) Two persons who represent or who are registrants under ORS**
5 **475B.400 to 475B.525, one of whom must be a member of the Advisory**
6 **Committee on Medial Marijuana;**
- 7 **“(H) One person who represents laboratories registered under ORS**
8 **475B.565;**
- 9 **“(I) One person who is a consumer of marijuana items and who is**
10 **not registered under ORS 475B.415;**
- 11 **“(J) One person who is registered under ORS 475B.415.**
- 12 **“(3) The task force shall study the goals and potential effects of**
13 **consolidating the programs regulating marijuana and marijuana-**
14 **derived products under ORS 475B.010 and 475B.395, including potential**
15 **price changes, the rights and privileges of persons registered under**
16 **ORS 475B.415, allowable grow canopy sizes and plant limits for**
17 **licensees under ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395 and registrants under ORS**
18 **475B.400 to 475B.525 and the sustainability of the program regulated**
19 **under ORS 475B.400 to 475B.525.**
- 20 **“(4) A majority of the voting members of the task force constitutes**
21 **a quorum for the transaction of business.**
- 22 **“(5) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a**
23 **majority of the voting members of the task force.**
- 24 **“(6) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as**
25 **chairperson.**
- 26 **“(7) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority**
27 **shall make an appointment to become immediately effective.**
- 28 **“(8) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the**
29 **call of the chairperson or of a majority of the voting members of the**
30 **task force, provided that the task force meets at least six times before**

1 **December 1, 2017.**

2 **“(9) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of**
3 **the task force.**

4 **“(10) The task force shall submit a report and may include recom-**
5 **mendations for administrative action to the Governor, the Oregon Li-**
6 **quor Control Commission and the Oregon Health Authority no later**
7 **than December 31, 2017.**

8 **“(11) The task force shall submit a report in the manner provided**
9 **by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to**
10 **an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to business**
11 **no later than December 31, 2017.**

12 **“(12) The Legislative Policy and Research Director may employ**
13 **persons necessary for the performance of the functions of the task**
14 **force. The Legislative Policy and Research Director shall fix the duties**
15 **and amounts of compensation of these employees. The task force shall**
16 **use the services of continuing legislative staff, without employing ad-**
17 **ditional persons, to the greatest extent practicable. The Legislative**
18 **Counsel shall prepare drafts of legislative concepts for the task force**
19 **upon request.**

20 **“(13) Members of the Legislative Assembly appointed to the task**
21 **force are nonvoting members of the task force and may act in an ad-**
22 **visory capacity only.**

23 **“(14) Members of the task force who are not members of the Leg-**
24 **islative Assembly are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement**
25 **for expenses and serve as volunteers on the task force.**

26 **“(15) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111,**
27 **are directed to assist the task force in the performance of the task**
28 **force’s duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to**
29 **confidentiality, to furnish information and advice the members of the**
30 **task force consider necessary to perform their duties.**

1 **“SECTION 36d. Notwithstanding any other provision of law:**

2 **“(1) The Oregon Health Authority may not impose a fee on or col-**
3 **lect a fee from a marijuana grow site, as defined in ORS 475B.410,**
4 **pursuant to any provision of ORS 475B.400 to 475B.525, until December**
5 **31, 2017; and**

6 **“(2) The system developed and maintained under ORS 475B.150 may**
7 **not be used to track any marijuana or marijuana-derived product**
8 **regulated under the provisions of ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395 until June**
9 **31, 2018.”.**

10 On page 39, after line 7, insert:

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“REPEALS

14 **“SECTION 85a. Sections 36c and 36d of this 2017 Act are repealed**
15 **on July 1, 2018.”.**

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
