**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2100**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 8, delete “seven” and insert  
2 “eight”.

3 In line 11, delete “11” and insert “12”.

4 In line 23, after “states” insert “, Oregon, Idaho, Montana, Wyoming,  
5 Nebraska, Iowa, Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, Pennsylvania, New York and  
6 Massachusetts.”.

7 In line 25, delete “1,987” and insert “1,947” and delete “50” and insert  
8 “55”.

9 On page 2, delete lines 14 through 45.

10 On page 3, delete lines 1 through 15 and insert:

11 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Transportation shall install and**  
12 **maintain roadside memorial signs or markers recognizing this state’s**  
13 **recipients of the Medal of Honor. The department may install and**  
14 **maintain additional signs and markers in roadside rest areas and**  
15 **turnouts.**

16 **“(2) The roadside memorial signs or markers must include the**  
17 **recipient’s name, an image of the Medal of Honor the recipient re-**  
18 **ceived and the name of the war or campaign, if any, during which the**  
19 **recipient received the medal. The names of the 26 recipients, the war**  
20 **or campaign, if any, during which they received the Medal of Honor**  
21 **and the locations of the signs or markers are as follows:**

- 1       **“(a) Alaric B. Chapin, Civil War, near Portland.**
- 2       **“(b) Hartwell B. Compson, Civil War, near Portland.**
- 3       **“(c) Nathan H. Edgerton, Civil War, near Agness.**
- 4       **“(d) Louis Renninger, Civil War, near Eugene.**
- 5       **“(e) James Jackson, Indian Campaigns, near Portland.**
- 6       **“(f) Nicholas Meaher, Indian Campaigns, near Jordan Valley.**
- 7       **“(g) Lewis Phife, Indian Campaigns, near Salem.**
- 8       **“(h) Frank C. High, Philippine Insurrection, near Medford.**
- 9       **“(i) Charles E. Kilbourne, Philippine Insurrection, near Portland.**
- 10       **“(j) Marcus W. Robertson, Philippine Insurrection, near Hood River.**
- 11       **“(k) Jacob Volz, Philippine Insurrection, near Portland.**
- 12       **“(L) John A. Murphy, Boxer Rebellion, near Portland.**
- 13       **“(m) Harry D. Fadden, peacetime, near The Dalles.**
- 14       **“(n) Edward C. Allworth, World War I, near Corvallis.**
- 15       **“(o) Arnold L. Bjorklund, World War II, near Portland.**
- 16       **“(p) Arthur J. Jackson, World War II, near Portland.**
- 17       **“(q) David R. Kingsley, World War II, near Portland.**
- 18       **“(r) Robert D. Maxwell, World War II, near Bend.**
- 19       **“(s) Henry Schauer, World War II, near Salem.**
- 20       **“(t) Stuart S. Stryker, World War II, near Portland.**
- 21       **“(u) Stanley T. Adams, Korean War, near The Dalles.**
- 22       **“(v) Loren R. Kaufman, Korean War, near The Dalles.**
- 23       **“(w) Larry G. Dahl, Vietnam War, near Portland.**
- 24       **“(x) John N. Holcomb, Vietnam War, near Richland.**
- 25       **“(y) Gary W. Martini, Vietnam War, near Portland.**
- 26       **“(z) Maximo Yabes, Vietnam War, near Oakridge.**
- 27       **“(3) The department shall include the same information described**
- 28 **in subsection (2) of this section on signs or markers for any recipients**
- 29 **awarded the Medal of Honor on or after January 1, 2017.**
- 30       **“(4)(a) The department may accept moneys from and may enter into**

1 agreements with veterans groups to create, install and maintain the  
2 signs and markers. The department may determine the number of  
3 signs or markers per city used to recognize the individuals connected  
4 to that city. More than one individual may be recognized on one sign  
5 or marker.

6 “(b) The department may not use public funds for the installation  
7 and maintenance of the signs or markers.

8 “SECTION 2. (1) The portion of U.S. Highway 20 beginning in  
9 Newport, Oregon, and ending at the Idaho state line shall also be  
10 known as the Oregon Medal of Honor Highway.

11 “(2) The Department of Transportation shall place and maintain  
12 along U.S. Highway 20 suitable signs or markers that include the des-  
13 ignation of the highway as the Oregon Medal of Honor Highway.

14 “(3) The department shall include images of all three versions of the  
15 Medal of Honor medals on signs and markers along the highway and  
16 at selected roadside rest areas and turnouts.

17 “(4) The signs and markers installed in roadside rest areas and  
18 turnouts must:

19 “(a) Include each Medal of Honor recipient’s name listed in section  
20 1 of this 2017 Act, an image of the Medal of Honor the recipient re-  
21 ceived and the name of the war or campaign, if any, during which the  
22 recipient received the medal;

23 “(b) Include a quick response code for the Congressional Medal of  
24 Honor Society; and

25 “(c) Be accessible to persons with disabilities.

26 “(5)(a) The department may accept moneys from and may enter into  
27 agreements with veterans groups to create, install and maintain the  
28 signs and markers.

29 “(b) The department may not use public funds for the installation  
30 and maintenance of the signs or markers.”.
