**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3313**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 20 through 22 and insert:

2 “(b)(A) A public charter school may give priority for admission to stu-
3 dents who reside within the attendance boundaries that were in effect at the
4 time a school district closed a nonchartered public school if:

5 “(i) The public charter school began to operate not more than two years
6 after the nonchartered public school was closed;

7 “(ii) The school district that closed the nonchartered public school is the
8 sponsor of the public charter school;

9 “(iii) The public charter school is physically located within the attend-
10 ance boundaries of the closed nonchartered public school; and

11 “(iv) The school district board, through board action, approved the public
12 charter school giving priority as described in this paragraph.

13 “(B) Nothing in this paragraph requires an amendment to a charter. A
14 school district board may take an action described in subparagraph (A)(iv)
15 of this paragraph at any time during the term of a charter.”.

16 On page 3, delete lines 42 through 44 and insert:

17 “(b)(A) A public charter school may give priority for admission to stu-
18 dents who reside within the attendance boundaries that were in effect at the
19 time a school district closed a nonchartered public school if:

20 “(i) The public charter school began to operate not more than two years
21 after the nonchartered public school was closed;
