**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 423**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “ORS” insert “431A.850 and”.

2 After line 31, insert:

3 “(5) A supervising physician or supervising physician organization that
4 supervises a physician assistant who is employed by or who contracts with
5 a pharmacy, as defined in ORS 431A.850 (4)(b), shall report the dispensation
6 of a controlled substance classified in Schedule III or IV under the federal
7 Controlled Substances Act, 21 U.S.C. 811 and 812, as modified under ORS
8 475.035, by the physician assistant to the Oregon Health Authority in com-
9 pliance with ORS 431A.855 to 431A.900.”.

10 On page 2, line 1, delete “(5)” and insert “(6)”.

11 After line 2, insert:

12 **“SECTION 2.** ORS 431A.850 is amended to read:

13 “431A.850. As used in ORS 431A.855 to 431A.900:

14 “(1) ‘Dispense’ and ‘dispensing’ have the meanings given those terms in
15 ORS 689.005.

16 “(2) ‘Drug outlet’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 689.005.

17 “(3) ‘Health professional regulatory board’ has the meaning given that
18 term in ORS 676.160.

19 **“(4) ‘Pharmacy’ means:**

20 **“(a) A pharmacy as defined in ORS 689.005; and**

21 **“(b) An urgent or immediate care clinic that:**

1 **“(A) Offers health care services without an appointment;**

2 **“(B) Is not licensed by the Oregon Health Authority under ORS**
3 **441.025;**

4 **“(C) Has arrangements with an emergency transportation provider**
5 **for the transport to, and with the nearest hospital for treatment at,**
6 **the hospital of patients who present at the clinic with a life-**
7 **threatening injury or medical condition or who need emergency med-**
8 **ical services as defined in ORS 441.094; and**

9 **“(D) Is staffed primarily by physician assistants, as defined in ORS**
10 **677.495.**

11 **“[(4)] (5) ‘Practitioner’ means:**

12 **“(a) A practitioner as defined in ORS 689.005; or**

13 **“(b) An individual licensed to practice a profession in California, Idaho**
14 **or Washington, if the requirements for licensure are similar, as determined**
15 **by the [*Oregon Health*] authority, to the requirements for being licensed as**
16 **a practitioner as defined in ORS 689.005.**

17 **“[(5)] (6) ‘Prescription’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 475.005.**

18 **“[(6)] (7) ‘Prescription drug’ has the meaning given that term in ORS**
19 **689.005.”.**

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
