**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2220**

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, after line 12, insert:

2 **“SECTION 2. If House Bill 2314 becomes law, section 1 of this 2017**
3 **Act (amending ORS 332.114) is repealed and ORS 332.114, as amended**
4 **by section 15, chapter __, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled House Bill 2314),**
5 **is amended to read:**

6 “332.114. (1) A person who meets the requirements under subsection (3)
7 of this section may request a school district to issue the person a high school
8 diploma if the person resides within the boundaries of the school district or
9 is a resident of this state and attended a high school of the school district.

10 “(2) A representative of a deceased person who meets the requirements
11 under subsection (3) of this section may request a school district to issue a
12 high school diploma on behalf of the deceased person if the deceased person
13 resided within the boundaries of the school district at the time of death or
14 was a resident of this state at the time of death and attended a high school
15 of the school district.

16 “(3) Notwithstanding the requirements for a high school diploma estab-
17 lished under ORS 329.451 and by the State Board of Education and school
18 districts, a school district that receives a request under subsection (1) or (2)
19 of this section shall issue a high school diploma to a person if the person:

20 “(a) Attended a high school before serving in the Armed Forces of the
21 United States;

1 “[*(b)* Did not graduate from a high school because the person was serving
2 in the Armed Forces of the United States;]

3 “[*(c)*] **(b)** Was discharged or released under honorable conditions from the
4 Armed Forces of the United States; **and**

5 “[*(d)*] **(c)** Served in the Armed Forces of the United States as described
6 in subsection (4) of this section. [; *and*]

7 “[*(e)*(A) *Has received a certificate for passing an approved high school*
8 *equivalency test such as the General Educational Development (GED) test;*]

9 “[*(B)* *Has received a post-secondary degree from a community college, public*
10 *university listed in ORS 352.002 or other generally accredited institution of*
11 *higher education; or]*

12 “[*(C)* *Has received a minimum score on the Armed Services Vocational*
13 *Aptitude Battery (ASVAB), as established by the Oregon Military Depart-*
14 *ment.*]

15 “(4) The provisions of subsection (3) of this section apply to a person who:

16 “(a) Served in the Armed Forces of the United States at any time during:

17 “(A) World War I;

18 “(B) World War II;

19 “(C) The Korean Conflict; or

20 “(D) The Vietnam War;

21 “(b) Served in the Armed Forces of the United States and was physically
22 present in:

23 “(A) Operation Urgent Fury (Grenada);

24 “(B) Operation Just Cause (Panama);

25 “(C) Operation Desert Shield/Desert Storm (the Persian Gulf War);

26 “(D) Operation Restore Hope (Somalia);

27 “(E) Operation Enduring Freedom (Afghanistan); or

28 “(F) Operation Iraqi Freedom (Iraq); or

29 “(c) Served in the Armed Forces of the United States in an area desig-
30 nated as a combat zone by the President of the United States.”.
