**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2321**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 6 through 21 and
2 insert:

3 **“SECTION 2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section,**
4 **after leaving the waters of this state with a boat, a person shall re-**
5 **move or open all drain plugs, bailers, valves or other devices used to**
6 **control the draining of water from ballast tanks, bilges, livewells and**
7 **motorwells before transporting a boat within this state.**

8 **“(2) Subsection (1) of this section does not apply to:**

9 **“(a) Marine sanitary systems;**

10 **“(b) A person who holds a permit issued pursuant to ORS 498.222**
11 **to transport fish; or**

12 **“(c) A person participating in a fishing tournament authorized by**
13 **the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, except that after weighing**
14 **the fish the person shall return to the boat launch site and drain the**
15 **boat as required under subsection (1) of this section.**

16 **“SECTION 3. ORS 830.565 is amended to read:**

17 **“830.565. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, a**
18 **person may not operate a [*manually propelled*] nonmotorized boat [*that is***
19 ***10 feet or more in length*] or a motorboat on the waters of this state without**
20 **first obtaining an aquatic invasive species prevention permit from the State**
21 **Marine Board under ORS 830.570.**

1 “(2) A person 13 years of age or younger is not required to obtain
2 an aquatic invasive species prevention permit to operate a nonmotor-
3 ized boat on the waters of this state.

4 “[(2)] (3) A person who obtains an aquatic invasive species prevention
5 permit for a [*manually propelled*] **nonmotorized** boat may use the permit on
6 any [*manually propelled*] **nonmotorized** boat the person operates on the
7 waters of this state.”.
