

Requested by JOINT COMMITTEE ON MARIJUANA REGULATION

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 56**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “declaring an emergency” and  
2 insert “prescribing an effective date”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 29 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part**  
5 **of sections 1 to 6, chapter 97, Oregon Laws 2016.**

6 **“SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall issue**  
7 **one or more orders providing for the use of one or more money**  
8 **transmission businesses licensed under ORS 717.200 to 717.320, 717.900**  
9 **and 717.905 that meet the qualifications set forth in subsection (2) of**  
10 **this section for the purpose of processing and keeping records of**  
11 **transactions occurring between licensees, consumers and other enti-**  
12 **ties or individuals authorized under the laws of this state to engage**  
13 **in the business of producing, processing, selling or testing marijuana**  
14 **items, as identified by the commission.**

15 **“(2) A money transmission business is qualified for purposes of this**  
16 **section if the business:**

17 **“(a) Is a Level 1 Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard**  
18 **(PCI DSS) validated provider;**

19 **“(b) Is certified by Europay, MasterCard and Visa (EMV);**

20 **“(c) Is capable of integrating with a minimum of 50 payment**  
21 **processors;**

1       “(d) Is able to demonstrate that the business has made more than  
2       **20 million transactions in each month during the 24-month period**  
3       **preceding the date on which the commission issues the order; and**

4       “(e) Meets any other qualification specified in the commission’s  
5       **order.**

6       “SECTION 3. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the  
7       **date on which the 2017 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative**  
8       **Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**
