- "SECTION 1. (1) The Legislative Assembly finds that:
- "(a) The current Oregon Criminal Code was written in 1971 and included the defined term 'mental disease or defect';
- 8 "(b) The term 'mental disease or defect' has origins in mid-19th 9 century English common law;
 - "(c) The term 'mental disease or defect' may carry a negative connotation;
 - "(d) The meaning of the term 'mental disease or defect' has been interpreted in multiple court decisions since enactment into law; and
 - "(e) It is necessary to replace the term 'mental disease or defect' with a new term while preserving the validity of all previous court decisions interpreting or otherwise involving the term 'mental disease or defect.'
- "(2) In consequence of the findings described in subsection (1) of this section, the purpose of this 2017 Act is to replace the term 'mental disease or defect' with the term 'qualifying mental disorder' and to retain the meaning of the replaced term, without making a substan-

1 tive change to Oregon law.".
