PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2019

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 29 and delete <u>page</u> 2 2 and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, 'business tax credit' has
the meaning given that term in ORS 314.752.

5 "(2) Notwithstanding ORS 314.835, a taxpayer that is subject to 6 corporate excise tax under ORS chapter 317 and that claims at least 7 \$5,000 in business tax credits during a tax year shall submit to the 8 Legislative Revenue Officer by December 1 of each year a statement 9 that lists:

10 "(a) The name of the taxpayer, as provided on the Oregon return.

11 "(b) The taxpayer's Oregon sales.

12 "(c) The taxpayer's Oregon taxable income.

"(d) The specific type of each business tax credit the taxpayer
 claims, the total amount of the tax credit and the grand total of all
 tax credits the taxpayer claimed.

16 "(e) The taxpayer's Oregon tax liability.

"(f) The total amount of Oregon property taxes the taxpayer paid
 during the tax year.

"(3) The Legislative Revenue Officer shall compile the information
 the Legislative Revenue Officer receives under subsection (2) of this
 section, ensuring that a complete set of information is available for

each taxpayer, and by February 1 of each year shall prepare and deliver to a committee or interim committee of the Legislative Assembly
that is related to taxation a report that provides the information the
Legislative Revenue Officer received in a form and format and with
contents that the committee specifies.

6 "(4) This section does not permit a disclosure of information for
7 which federal law prohibits disclosure.

8 "(5) This section does not apply to a business tax credit that a tax-9 payer purchased or that the taxpayer received as a result of making 10 a donation.

"SECTION 2. (1) A business entity shall first submit the informa tion required under section 1 of this 2017 Act for the 2015 tax year to
 the Legislative Revenue Officer not later than December 1, 2017.

"(2) The Legislative Revenue Officer shall submit the first report
 required under section 1 of this 2017 Act not later than February 1,
 2018, for the 2015 tax year.

"SECTION 3. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
 date on which the 2017 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative
 Assembly adjourns sine die.".

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
