## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 56

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, line 2, delete "declaring an emergency" and 2 insert "prescribing an effective date".

3 Delete lines 4 through 29 and delete page 2 and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part
of ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395.

6 "<u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The medical staff of a long term care facility, as 7 defined in ORS 442.015, may directly deliver to the residents of the long 8 term care facility, and administer for the residents of the long term 9 care facility, cannabinoid products intended to be applied to the skin 10 or hair if:

"(a) The long term care facility obtains the cannabinoid products
from a marijuana wholesaler that holds a license issued under ORS
475B.100 or a marijuana retailer that holds a license issued under ORS
475B.110;

"(b) The cannabinoid products are not intended to be inhaled or
 ingested;

17 "(c) The cannabinoid products are nonpsychoactive; and

"(d) The long term care facility and the medical staff of the long
 term care facility meet any other requirement established by the De partment of Human Services by rule.

21 "(2) The medical staff of a long term care facility who directly de-

liver or administer cannabinoid products intended to be applied to the skin or hair in accordance with this section are exempt from the criminal and civil laws of this state for possession or delivery of marijuana items, or any other criminal offense in which possession or delivery of marijuana items is an element.".
