

Requested by Senator BURDICK

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 56**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “declaring an emergency” and
2 insert “prescribing an effective date”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 29 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part**
5 **of ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395.**

6 **“SECTION 2. (1) The medical staff of a long term care facility, as**
7 **defined in ORS 442.015, may directly deliver to the residents of the long**
8 **term care facility, and administer for the residents of the long term**
9 **care facility, cannabinoid products intended to be applied to the skin**
10 **or hair if:**

11 **“(a) The long term care facility obtains the cannabinoid products**
12 **from a marijuana wholesaler that holds a license issued under ORS**
13 **475B.100 or a marijuana retailer that holds a license issued under ORS**
14 **475B.110;**

15 **“(b) The cannabinoid products are not intended to be inhaled or**
16 **ingested;**

17 **“(c) The cannabinoid products are nonpsychoactive; and**

18 **“(d) The long term care facility and the medical staff of the long**
19 **term care facility meet any other requirement established by the De-**
20 **partment of Human Services by rule.**

21 **“(2) The medical staff of a long term care facility who directly de-**

1 **liver or administer cannabinoid products intended to be applied to the**
2 **skin or hair in accordance with this section are exempt from the**
3 **criminal and civil laws of this state for possession or delivery of**
4 **marijuana items, or any other criminal offense in which possession**
5 **or delivery of marijuana items is an element.”.**
