PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 56

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete "declaring an emergency" and insert "prescribing an effective date".
- 3 Delete lines 4 through 29 and delete page 2 and insert:
- "SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395.
- "SECTION 2. (1) A licensee may provide samples of marijuana items to attendees of a trade show or a similar event if:
- "(a) The transport of the marijuana items to the trade show or similar event comports with section 17, chapter ____, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 1057);
- "(b) The licensee annually registers with the Oregon Liquor Control
 Commission, in a form and manner prescribed by the commission, for
 the purpose of providing samples of marijuana items;
- 14 "(c) The licensee pays any registration fee adopted by the commis-15 sion;
- "(d) The licensee provides the samples of marijuana items to consumers attending the trade show or similar event under the terms of a plan submitted to the commission under subsection (2) of this section;
- 20 "(e) The licensee provides the samples of marijuana items in ac-21 cordance with the provisions of ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395 and rules

- adopted under ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395 that govern the sale of marijuana items to consumers, except as expressly exempted by the commission by rule; and
 - "(f) The licensee meets any other qualification specified by the commission by rule or order.
 - "(2) A trade show or a similar event may be used for the provision of samples of marijuana items to attendees of the trade show or similar event if a licensee or other person associated with the trade show or similar event submits to the commission, in a form and manner prescribed by the commission, a plan under which a consumer attending the trade show or similar event will be prevented from receiving an amount of marijuana in excess of the amount specified in section 3 (1)(b), chapter 21, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 302), and an amount of marijuana items in excess of amounts specified in rules adopted for the purpose of correlating the amount of marijuana specified in section 3 (1)(b), chapter 21, Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 302), to other marijuana items.
 - "(3) Fees adopted under this section must be reasonably calculated to not exceed the cost of administering this section. Fees collected under this section shall be deposited in the Marijuana Control and Regulation Fund established under ORS 475B.240. Moneys deposited in the fund under this subsection are continuously appropriated to the commission for the purpose of administering this section.
 - "SECTION 3. If Senate Bill 1057 does not become law, sections 1 and 2 of this 2017 Act are repealed.
 - "SECTION 4. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2017 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.".
