PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 56

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, line 2, delete "declaring an emergency" and 2 insert "prescribing an effective date".

3 Delete lines 4 through 29 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 "SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part
5 of ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395.

"SECTION 2. A marijuana retailer that holds a license issued under
ORS 475B.110 may provide samples of cannabinoid products intended
to be applied to the skin and hair to the attendees of a trade show, the
Oregon State Fair or a similar event if:

"(1) The transport of the cannabinoid products to the trade show,
Oregon State Fair or event comports with section 17, chapter ____,
Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 1057);

"(2) The cannabinoid products are not intended to be inhaled or
 ingested;

15 **"(3)** The cannabinoid products are nonpsychoactive;

"(4) The marijuana retailer provides the samples of cannabinoid
 products in accordance with the provisions of ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395
 and rules adopted under ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395 that govern the sale
 of marijuana items to consumers, except as expressly exempted by the
 Oregon Liquor Control Commission by rule; and

21 "(5) The marijuana retailer meets any other qualification specified

- 1 by the commission by rule or order.
- 2 "SECTION 3. If Senate Bill 1057 does not become law, sections 1 and
- 3 2 of this 2017 Act are repealed.
