

Requested by Senator BURDICK

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 56**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “declaring an emergency” and
2 insert “prescribing an effective date”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 29 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part**
5 **of ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395.**

6 **“SECTION 2. A marijuana retailer that holds a license issued under**
7 **ORS 475B.110 may provide samples of cannabinoid products intended**
8 **to be applied to the skin and hair to the attendees of a trade show, the**
9 **Oregon State Fair or a similar event if:**

10 **“(1) The transport of the cannabinoid products to the trade show,**
11 **Oregon State Fair or event comports with section 17, chapter __,**
12 **Oregon Laws 2017 (Enrolled Senate Bill 1057);**

13 **“(2) The cannabinoid products are not intended to be inhaled or**
14 **ingested;**

15 **“(3) The cannabinoid products are nonpsychoactive;**

16 **“(4) The marijuana retailer provides the samples of cannabinoid**
17 **products in accordance with the provisions of ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395**
18 **and rules adopted under ORS 475B.010 to 475B.395 that govern the sale**
19 **of marijuana items to consumers, except as expressly exempted by the**
20 **Oregon Liquor Control Commission by rule; and**

21 **“(5) The marijuana retailer meets any other qualification specified**

1 by the commission by rule or order.

2 **“SECTION 3. If Senate Bill 1057 does not become law, sections 1 and**
3 **2 of this 2017 Act are repealed.**

4 **“SECTION 4. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the**
5 **date on which the 2017 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative**
6 **Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**
