PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 56

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, line 2, delete "declaring an emergency" and 2 insert "prescribing an effective date".

3 Delete lines 4 through 29 and delete page 2 and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part
 of sections 1 to 6, chapter 97, Oregon Laws 2016.

"SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall issue 6 one or more orders providing for the use of one or more service pro-7 viders that meet the qualifications set forth in subsection (2) of this 8 section for the purpose of processing and keeping records of trans-9 actions occurring between licensees, consumers and other entities or 10 individuals authorized under the laws of this state to engage in the 11 business of producing, processing, selling or testing marijuana items, 12 as identified by the commission. 13

"(2) A service provider is qualified for purposes of this section if the
 business:

"(a) Is a Level 1 Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard
 (PCI DSS) validated provider;

"(c) Is capable of integrating with a minimum of 50 payment
 processors;

21 "(d) Is able to demonstrate that the business has made more than

20 million transactions in each month during the 24-month period
 preceding the date on which the commission issues the order; and
 "(e) Meets any other qualification specified in the commission's
 order.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
date on which the 2017 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative
Assembly adjourns sine die.".
