- law, any person who violates or who procures, aids or abets [in] the violation
- of ORS 59.005 to 59.451, 59.710 to 59.830, 59.991 and 59.995 or any rule or
- order of the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services
- shall be subject to a penalty of not more than \$20,000 for every violation,

- separate offense and, in the case of a continuing violation, each day's con-

- 4 "(3) Civil penalties under this section shall be imposed as provided in 5 ORS 183.745.
- 6 "(4) This section does not apply to a failure to file a notice and pay a fee 7 pursuant to ORS 59.049 (1), (2) or (3), nor to a failure to file a notice and
- 8 pay a fee pursuant to ORS 59.165 (7), nor to a failure to pay a fee pursuant
- 9 to ORS 59.175 (8), nor to a violation of any rule adopted by the director un-
