- 8 "(a) 'Community college' has the meaning given that term in ORS 9 341.005.
- "(b) 'Public university' means any institution established as a public university under ORS 352.002.
- "(c)(A) 'Veteran' has the meaning given that term in ORS 408.225.
- 13 "(B) 'Veteran' includes a disabled veteran as defined in ORS 408.225.
- "(2) The Department of Veterans' Affairs shall develop and imple-14 ment one or more programs statewide to establish or expand campus 15 veteran resource centers and campus veteran resource coordinators 16 on the campuses of community colleges and public universities. The 17 purpose of the programs is to help veterans successfully transition 18 from military service to college life, succeed in college, complete edu-19 cational goals and transition from college to the workforce and the 20 community. 21
  - "(3) The department shall implement programs under this section by awarding grants to community colleges or public universities that:
  - "(a) Establish new, or expand and enhance existing, campus veteran resource centers on campus premises;
- "(b) Recruit and employ campus veteran resource coordinators who can serve as liaisons to provide advocacy, understanding and resource connections for veterans;
- 29 "(c) Attract veterans to enroll in and attend educational programs
  30 at community colleges and public universities;

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- "(d) Provide assistance, guidance and support to veterans in com-1 pleting educational goals and objectives; 2
- "(e) Provide resources to college administration, faculty and staff 3 to facilitate an understanding and appreciation of the strengths, 4 unique challenges and needs of veterans and their families; 5
- "(f) Refer campus veterans to local county veterans' service officers 6 appointed under ORS 408.410 who assist veterans in obtaining federal and state veteran benefits; 8
- "(g) Assist veterans in successfully transitioning to work and com-9 munity life by connecting veterans with workforce and employment resources; and
  - "(h) Provide resources and matching funds in an amount to be determined by the department.
  - "(4) The department shall provide two types of grants to community colleges and public universities under this section as follows:
  - "(a) Grants to campuses with existing campus veteran resource centers and campus veteran resource coordinators for expansion and enhancement including, but not limited to, training for campus veteran coordinators, computer and other equipment and supplies, additional staff, veteran events, access to workforce and community resources that were not previously available and meeting other identified needs for the successful and continued operation of the existing centers and coordinators; and
  - "(b) Grants to campuses that do not currently have campus veteran resource centers or campus veteran resource coordinators to establish new centers and recruit and employ coordinators.
    - "(5) In addition to awarding grants, the department shall:
- "(a) Create opportunities for campus veteran resource coordinators 28 to network with each other to share best practices, resources and 29 other relevant information; 30

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- "(b) Provide training to campus veteran resource coordinators on specific topics that will benefit veterans before, during and after college life; and
  - "(c) Provide technical assistance in establishing and maintaining centers and coordinators on campuses.
  - "(6) Services and assistance provided through the campus veteran resource centers and campus veteran resource coordinators may not duplicate services provided by county veterans' service officers appointed under ORS 408.410, as described in ORS 406.450, but may provide additional information and aid that is not available through county veterans' service officers.
  - "(7) The department may collaborate and work with the Higher Education Coordinating Commission in developing and implementing programs under this section.
  - "(8) The department may solicit and accept gifts, grants and donations from public and private sources to further the purposes of this section.
  - "(9) The department may adopt rules to implement the provisions of this section.
  - "SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Veterans' Affairs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_, which may be expended for the purposes of implementing section 1 of this 2017 Act.
  - "SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect July 1, 2017."

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
