**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 48**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 6 through 25 and
2 delete page 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

4 **“(a) ‘Board’ means:**

5 **“(A) Occupational Therapy Licensing Board;**

6 **“(B) Oregon Board of Licensed Professional Counselors and Thera-**
7 **pists;**

8 **“(C) Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine;**

9 **“(D) Oregon Medical Board;**

10 **“(E) Oregon State Board of Nursing;**

11 **“(F) Physical Therapist Licensing Board;**

12 **“(G) State Board of Chiropractic Examiners;**

13 **“(H) State Board of Licensed Social Workers;**

14 **“(I) State Board of Psychologist Examiners; and**

15 **“(J) Teacher Standards and Practices Commission.**

16 **“(b) ‘Licensee’ means a person authorized to practice one of the**
17 **following professions:**

18 **“(A) Clinical social worker, as defined in ORS 675.510;**

19 **“(B) Licensed marriage and family therapist, as defined in ORS**
20 **675.705;**

21 **“(C) Licensed professional counselor, as defined in ORS 675.705;**

- 1 **“(D) Licensed psychologist, as defined in ORS 675.010;**
2 **“(E) Occupational therapist, as defined in ORS 675.210;**
3 **“(F) Regulated social worker, as defined in ORS 675.510;**
4 **“(G) School counselor, as defined by rule by the Teacher Standards**
5 **and Practices Commission;**
6 **“(H) Certified registered nurse anesthetist, as defined in ORS**
7 **678.245;**
8 **“(I) Chiropractic physician, as defined in ORS 684.010;**
9 **“(J) Clinical nurse specialist, as defined in ORS 678.010;**
10 **“(K) Naturopathic physician, as defined in ORS 685.010;**
11 **“(L) Nurse practitioner, as defined in ORS 678.010;**
12 **“(M) Physician, as defined in ORS 677.010;**
13 **“(N) Physician assistant, as defined in ORS 677.495;**
14 **“(O) Physical therapist, as defined in ORS 688.010; and**
15 **“(P) Physical therapist assistant, as defined in ORS 688.010.**
16 **“(2) In collaboration with the Oregon Health Authority, a board**
17 **shall adopt rules to require a licensee regulated by the board to report**
18 **to the board, upon reauthorization to practice, the licensee’s com-**
19 **pletion of any continuing education regarding suicide risk assessment,**
20 **treatment and management.**
21 **“(3) A licensee shall report the completion of any continuing edu-**
22 **cation described in subsection (2) of this section to the board that**
23 **regulates the licensee.**
24 **“(4)(a) A board shall document completion of any continuing edu-**
25 **cation described in subsection (2) of this section by a licensee regu-**
26 **lated by the board. The board shall document the following data:**
27 **“(A) The number of licensees who complete continuing education**
28 **described in subsection (2) of this section;**
29 **“(B) The percentage of the total of all licensees who complete the**
30 **continuing education;**

1 **“(C) The counties in which licensees who complete the continuing**
2 **education practice; and**

3 **“(D) The contact information for licensees willing to share infor-**
4 **mation about suicide risk assessment, treatment and management**
5 **with the authority.**

6 **“(b) The board shall remove any personally identifying information**
7 **from the data submitted to the board under this subsection, except for**
8 **the personally identifying information of licensees willing to share**
9 **such information with the authority.**

10 **“(c) For purposes of documenting completion of continuing educa-**
11 **tion under this subsection, a board may adopt rules requiring licensees**
12 **to submit documentation of completion to the board.**

13 **“(5) A board, on or before March 1 of each even-numbered year,**
14 **shall report to the authority on the data documented under subsection**
15 **(4) of this section, as well as information about any initiatives by the**
16 **board to promote suicide risk assessment, treatment and management**
17 **among its licensees.**

18 **“(6) The authority, on or before August 1 of each even-numbered**
19 **year, shall report to the interim committees of the Legislative As-**
20 **sembly related to health care on the information submitted to the**
21 **authority under subsection (5) of this section. The authority shall**
22 **include in the report information about initiatives by boards to pro-**
23 **mote awareness about suicide risk assessment, treatment and man-**
24 **agement and information on how boards are promoting continuing**
25 **education described in subsection (2) of this section to licensees.**

26 **“(7) The authority may use the information submitted to the au-**
27 **thority under subsection (5) of this section to develop continuing edu-**
28 **cation opportunities related to suicide risk assessment, treatment and**
29 **management for licensees and to facilitate improvements in suicide**
30 **risk assessment, treatment and management efforts in this state.**
