**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 3047**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 7, after “operates” insert
2 “or causes to be operated”.

3 In line 8, after “operates” insert “or causes to be operated”.

4 Delete lines 11 through 27.

5 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 5 and insert:

6 “(2) Subsection (1) of this section does not apply if:

7 “(a) The person uses the unmanned aircraft system to release, discharge,
8 propel or eject a nonlethal projectile for purposes other than to injure or
9 kill persons or animals;

10 “(b) The person uses the unmanned aircraft system in compliance with
11 specific authorization from the Federal Aviation Administration;

12 “(c) The person notifies the Oregon Department of Aviation, the Oregon
13 State Police and any other agency that issues a permit or license for the
14 activity requiring the use of the unmanned aircraft system that the person
15 intends to use an unmanned aircraft system that is capable of releasing,
16 discharging, propelling or ejecting a projectile at least five days before the
17 person uses the system; and

18 “(d) The person provides reasonable notice to the public if the person in-
19 tends to use an unmanned aircraft system that is capable of releasing, dis-
20 charging, propelling or ejecting a projectile in an area open to the public.

21 “(3) The notification requirement of subsection (2)(c) of this section does

1 not apply to:

2 “(a) A career school licensed under ORS 345.010 to 345.450;

3 “(b) A community college as defined in ORS 341.005;

4 “(c) An education service district as defined in ORS 334.003;

5 “(d) The Oregon Health and Science University;

6 “(e) A public high school;

7 “(f) A public university listed in ORS 352.002; or

8 “(g) An institution that is exempt from ORS 348.594 to 348.615 under ORS
9 348.597 (2).

10 “(4) Notwithstanding subsection (2) of this section, a person may not use
11 an unmanned aircraft system that is capable of releasing, discharging, pro-
12 pelling or ejecting a projectile for purposes of crowd management.”.
