**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 3262**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 19, delete “of more than
2 two doses”.

3 In line 20, delete “, gerontologist or”.

4 In line 21, delete “psychiatrist” and insert “or mental health care
5 provider”.

6 In line 23, delete “, gerontologist or psychiatrist” and insert “or mental
7 health care provider”.

8 In line 27, delete “and”.

9 After line 27, insert:

10 “(b) A licensed health care practitioner other than the primary care pro-
11 vider or mental health care provider, or other licensed health care practi-
12 tioner designated by the department, of the elderly person or person with a
13 disability who prescribes a psychotropic medication notify the primary care
14 provider or mental health care provider, or other licensed health care prac-
15 titioner designated by the department, of the elderly person or person with
16 a disability of the prescription not later than 24 hours after issuing the
17 prescription;

18 “(c) Psychotropic medication prescribed by a licensed health care practi-
19 tioner other than the primary care provider or mental health care provider,
20 or other licensed health care practitioner designated by the department, of
21 the elderly person or person with a disability may be in an amount sufficient

1 for a seven-day supply; and”.

2 In line 28, delete “(b)” and insert “(d)”.

3 On page 2, delete lines 2 through 8 and insert:

4 “(A) A person-centered assessment has been performed for the elderly
5 person or person with a disability; and

6 “(B) Based on the findings of the assessment, the best course of treatment,
7 including the use of nonpharmacological interventions, psychotropic
8 medication or a combination of nonpharmacological interventions and
9 psychotropic medication, is followed.”.

10 After line 10, insert:

11 **“SECTION 2. The Department of Human Services shall convene an
12 advisory committee of stakeholders and of representatives from the
13 department, the State Board of Pharmacy, the Oregon Medical Board,
14 the Oregon State Board of Nursing and the Long Term Care Ombuds-
15 man to study and make recommendations for best practices related to
16 the implementation of section 1 of this 2017 Act. The department shall
17 submit the findings and recommendations from the study to an in-
18 terim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to human ser-
19 vices not later than December 31, 2017.**

20 **“SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2017 Act applies to prescriptions for
21 psychotropic medication issued on or after the effective date of this
22 2017 Act by a licensed health care practitioner other than the primary
23 care provider or mental health care provider, or other licensed health
24 care practitioner designated by the Department of Human Services,
25 of an elderly person or person with a disability.”.**

26 In line 11, delete “2” and insert “4”.

27 In line 18, delete “3” and insert “5”.

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
