PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 56

- On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 29 and delete page 2 and insert:
- "SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 475B.400 to 475B.525.
- "SECTION 2. (1) Subject to subsection (2) of this section, a marijuana grow site may transfer up to 20 pounds of usable marijuana per year to a person that holds a license issued under ORS 475B.090 or 475B.100, provided that:
- 9 "(a) The transfer is tracked using the system developed and main-10 tained under ORS 475B.150;
- 11 "(b) More than 12 mature marijuana plants are produced at the 12 marijuana grow site;
- 13 "(c) The usable marijuana has been assigned to the person respon-14 sible for the marijuana grow site pursuant to ORS 475B.425;
- 15 "(d) The usable marijuana has been tested in accordance with the 16 provisions of ORS 475B.550 to 475B.590; and
- "(e) The marijuana grow site first registered with the Oregon Health Authority under ORS 475B.420 on or before the effective date of this 2017 Act.
- 20 "(2) If the Oregon Liquor Control Commission determines that the 21 supply of marijuana items offered for sale by marijuana retailers that

- 1 hold a license issued under ORS 475B.110 is exceeding consumer de-
- 2 mand for the marijuana items, and if the commission determines that
- 3 the market for marijuana items in this state will not self-correct for
- 4 the excess, the commission may issue an order that temporarily re-
- 5 duces the amount of usable marijuana that may be transferred pur-
- 6 suant to this section or that temporarily suspends the ability to
- 7 transfer usable marijuana pursuant to this section.

8 "SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate 9 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is

declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage.".
