**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3459**

- 1 On page 2 of the printed bill, delete lines 37 through 43 and insert:
- 2 “(B) At least 75 percent of regularly scheduled staff hours at the retail
3 store are worked by volunteers; and
- 4 “(C) All net proceeds of the retail store sales are donated:
- 5 “(i) To an animal shelter;
- 6 “(ii) To a nonprofit corporation dedicated to the welfare of animals;
- 7 “(iii) To a manufacturer or provider of goods or services in return for
8 which an animal shelter receives an equivalent value of goods or services
9 from the manufacturer or provider;
- 10 “(iv) To an entity that provides spaying and neutering services for pets
11 of individuals residing in households with an annual household income at
12 or below 80 percent of the area median income; or
- 13 “(v) For the purpose of aiding domesticated animals in emergency or
14 dangerous situations, regardless of whether the animals are in the custody
15 of the county shelter.”.
- 16 On page 4, delete lines 35 through 41 and insert:
- 17 “(B) At least 75 percent of regularly scheduled staff hours at the retail
18 store are worked by volunteers; and
- 19 “(C) All net proceeds of the retail store sales are donated:
- 20 “(i) To an animal shelter;
- 21 “(ii) To a nonprofit corporation dedicated to the welfare of animals;
