**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 3443**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “and” and after “459A.718”  
2 insert “and section 4, chapter 106, Oregon Laws 2013; and repealing section  
3 5, chapter 106, Oregon Laws 2013”.

4 On page 2, after line 44, insert:

5 “(8) Except for the percentages described in subsection (6) of this section  
6 or in a proceeding under ORS 459A.717 for a violation of subsection (5) of  
7 this section, the commission may disclose information provided to the com-  
8 mission by a distributor, an importer or a distributor cooperative only at  
9 aggregate levels that do not disclose individually identifiable information.

10 **“SECTION 2. Section 5, chapter 106, Oregon Laws 2013, is repealed.**

11 **“SECTION 3. Section 4, chapter 106, Oregon Laws 2013, is added to  
12 and made a part of ORS 459A.700 to 459A.740.**

13 **“SECTION 4.** Section 4, chapter 106, Oregon Laws 2013, is amended to  
14 read:

15 **“Sec. 4.** No later than [*March 1 of each odd-numbered year*] **September**  
16 **15 of each year**, the Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall submit a  
17 **beverage container** report to the Legislative Assembly [*regarding beverage*  
18 *container redemption centers approved pursuant to the provisions of ORS*  
19 *459A.737*] **in the manner provided by ORS 192.245.** The report must in-  
20 clude, for the [*two*] previous calendar [*years*] **year:**

21 “(1) [*The number of beverage containers that are returned for refund value*”

1 *as a percentage of the total number of beverage containers sold in this state.]*  
2 **The calculations and percentages required to be posted on the**  
3 **commission’s website under ORS 459A.718 (6).**

4 “(2) The number of beverage container redemption centers operating in  
5 this state and the number of redemption centers for which applications are  
6 pending with the commission.

7 “(3) The number of beverage containers that are returned for refund value  
8 [*in areas designated by the commission and the number of beverage containers*  
9 *returned for refund value in each area*] **regionally, as designated by the**  
10 **commission in consultation with distributor cooperatives, during the**  
11 **calendar year and** in the year before the beverage container redemption  
12 center began operation.

13 “(4) The number of beverage containers that are returned for refund value  
14 to beverage container redemption centers in this state and the number of  
15 beverage containers that are returned for refund value to dealers in this  
16 state.”.

17 Delete line 45 and delete page 3 and insert:

18 **“SECTION 5. The amendments to ORS 459A.718 and section 4,**  
19 **chapter 106, Oregon Laws 2013, by sections 1 and 4 of this 2017 Act first**  
20 **apply to beverage container return data and other relevant beverage**  
21 **container data submitted to the Oregon Liquor Control Commission**  
22 **for the 2017 calendar year.”.**
