3 Delete lines 4 through 15 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law appropriating money,  
5 limiting expenditures or otherwise adjusting appropriations or ex-  
6 penditure limitations, and in addition to any action by the Emergency  
7 Board, the authorized appropriations for the biennium ending June 30,  
8 2017, for the following agencies and programs are changed by the  
9 amounts specified:**

11 **“SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**  
12 **ation, there is appropriated to the State Forestry Department, for the**  
13 **Agency Administration division, for the biennium ending June 30, 2017,**  
14 **out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,689,072, for the purpose of**  
15 **purchasing a catastrophic wildfire insurance policy for the 2017 fire**  
16 **season.**

17 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
18 **the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (1), chapter 809,**  
19 **Oregon Laws 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses**  
20 **from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts**  
21 **and including federal funds from the United States Forest Service for**  
22 **fire protection and for research projects, but excluding lottery funds**  
23 **and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter 809, Oregon Laws**  
24 **2015, collected or received by the State Forestry Department, is in-**  
25 **creased by \$1,689,072 for the purpose of purchasing a catastrophic**  
26 **wildfire insurance policy for the 2017 fire season.**

27 **“SECTION 4. Sections 67 and 68, chapter 82, Oregon Laws 2016, are**  
28 **repealed.**

29 **“SECTION 5. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
30 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**

1 **declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**
