- 6 "Whereas the term 'mental disease or defect' has origins in mid-19th
- 7 century English common law; and
- 8 "Whereas the term 'mental disease or defect' may carry a negative
- 9 connotation; and
- "Whereas the meaning of the term 'mental disease or defect' has been
- interpreted in multiple court decisions since enactment into law; and
- "Whereas the Legislative Assembly intends to replace the term 'mental
- disease or defect' with a new term while preserving the validity of all pre-
- 14 vious court decisions interpreting or otherwise involving the term 'mental
- 15 disease or defect'; and
- "Whereas the purpose of this 2017 Act is to replace the term 'mental
- disease or defect' with the term 'qualifying mental disorder' and to retain the
- 18 meaning of the replaced term, without making a substantive change to
- 19 Oregon law; now, therefore,".
- Delete lines 7 through 21.
- In line 22, delete "1a" and insert "1".
