**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2020**

1 On page 2 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 18, delete “, facilities”.

2 In line 25, after “6” insert “, 6a”.

3 In line 34, after “as” insert “nonvoting,”.

4 In line 36, delete “five” and insert “seven”.

5 In line 44, delete “and”.

6 In line 45, delete the period and insert “; and

7 “(f) Two at-large members.”.

8 On page 3, line 3, delete “conduction” and insert “conducting” and delete
9 “which” and insert “that,” and after “state” insert a comma.

10 In line 12, delete “its” and insert “the voting”.

11 In line 15, before “members” insert “voting”.

12 On page 4, after line 8, insert:

14 **“(Energy Industry Advisory Committee)**

16 **“SECTION 6a. (1) There is created an Energy Industry Advisory**
17 **Committee consisting of nine members appointed by the Oregon En-**
18 **ergy and Climate Board as follows:**

19 **“(a) Two members who represent electric investor-owned utilities**
20 **as that term is defined in ORS 469.631;**

21 **“(b) One member who represents a natural gas investor-owned**

1 utility as that term is defined in ORS 469.631;

2 “(c) Two members who represent consumer-owned utilities as that
3 term is defined in ORS 469A.005;

4 “(d) One member who represents the interests of renewable energy
5 developers;

6 “(e) One member who represents the interests of energy efficiency
7 contractors; and

8 “(f) Two at-large members.

9 “(2) The committee shall provide information and recommendations
10 to the board on:

11 “(a) Energy production, distribution and utilization;

12 “(b) Energy portfolio resources and energy infrastructure
13 resiliency;

14 “(c) Energy industry trends related to matters described in para-
15 graphs (a) and (b) of this subsection; and

16 “(d) Proposals by the Oregon Department of Energy and Climate
17 related to planning, policy and technical analysis.

18 “(3) Members of the committee shall be appointed to serve for terms
19 of four years each. A vacancy on the committee shall be filled by ap-
20 pointment by the board for the unexpired term.

21 “(4) The committee shall select from among themselves a chair-
22 person and any other officers with such terms and duties as the com-
23 mittee considers necessary. A majority of the members of the
24 committee constitutes a quorum. The committee shall meet at least
25 two times per year at the call of the chairperson of the board.

26 “(5) Members of the committee are not entitled to compensation
27 or reimbursement for expenses and shall serve as volunteers on the
28 committee.

29 “(6) The Oregon Department of Energy and Climate shall provide
30 personnel services to assist the committee within the limits of avail-

1 **able funds.”.**

2 In line 25, delete the second “and”.

3 After line 25, insert:

4 “(m) The Director of the Oregon Health Authority; and”.

5 In line 26, delete “(m)” and insert “(n)”.

6 Delete lines 30 through 36 and insert:

7 “(2) The committee shall, as requested by the Oregon Energy and Climate
8 Board:

9 “(a) Collaborate to identify and evaluate existing programs, policies,
10 projects and activities in order to make recommendations to the Oregon
11 Energy and Climate Board and the Legislative Assembly on ways to coordi-
12 nate state policies, programs, projects and activities related to energy and
13 climate, with a focus on better coordination of policies or programs so as to
14 increase the effectiveness of efforts to reduce greenhouse gas emissions in
15 Oregon while achieving the mission and purpose of each agency represented
16 on the committee; and

17 “(b) Develop recommendations and strategies for:

18 “(A) State actions that may be taken to help mitigate and adapt to the
19 impacts of climate change; and

20 “(B) The utilization and development of resources for funding state pro-
21 grams, projects and activities related to mitigating and adapting to the im-
22 pacts of climate change.”.
