**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 5017**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 27 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Legislative Adminis-**
4 **tration Committee, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the**
5 **General Fund, the following amounts for payment of the expenses of**
6 **the Legislative Administration Committee, for the following purposes:**

- 7 (1) General program..... \$ 24,336,204
8 (2) Debt service \$ 12,873,776

9 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
10 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**
11 **1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees,**
12 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
13 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the**
14 **Legislative Administration Committee:**

- 15 (1) General program..... \$ 2,453,495
16 (2) Debt service \$ 1,192,375

17 **“SECTION 3. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, expenditures**
18 **by the Legislative Administration Committee from the Stores Revolv-**
19 **ing Account and the Property and Supplies Stores Account established**
20 **in ORS 173.790 are not limited.**

21 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**

1 the amount of \$300,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
2 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,
3 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
4 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the
5 Legislative Administration Committee, for expenses related to the
6 Oregon Capitol History Gateway from the Oregon Capitol History
7 Gateway Fund.

8 **“SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
9 the amount of \$25,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
10 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,
11 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
12 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the
13 Legislative Administration Committee, for expenses related to oper-
14 ations for the Oregon State Capitol Foundation from the Oregon State
15 Capitol Foundation Operating Fund.

16 **“SECTION 6.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for
17 the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the
18 amount of \$14,345,214 for payment of the expenses of the following of-
19 fices:

20 **“(1)** The offices of the President of the Senate and the Speaker of
21 the House of Representatives;

22 **“(2)** The majority and minority offices of the Senate and of the
23 House of Representatives; and

24 **“(3)** The offices of the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk
25 of the House of Representatives.

26 **“SECTION 7.** (1) There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly,
27 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the
28 amount of \$18,041,769 for payment of the expenses of members of the
29 Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

30 **“(2)** There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the

1 biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount
2 of \$9,305,980 for payment of the expenses of members of the Eightieth
3 Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

4 **“SECTION 8.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
5 the amount of \$26,570 is established for the biennium beginning July
6 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,
7 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
8 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the
9 Legislative Assembly.

10 **“SECTION 9.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, expenditures
11 by the Legislative Assembly from the Lounge Revolving Account es-
12 tablished in ORS 171.117, for the costs of food served in members’
13 lounges and reimbursed through receipts on the basis of sales or by
14 payroll deductions from members, are not limited.

15 **“SECTION 10.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Counsel
16 Committee, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General
17 Fund, the amount of \$12,785,719.

18 **“SECTION 11.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
19 the amount of \$1,638,291 is established for the biennium beginning July
20 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,
21 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
22 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the
23 Legislative Counsel Committee.

24 **“SECTION 12.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, expendi-
25 tures by the Legislative Counsel Committee from the ORS Revolving
26 Account established in ORS 171.305 and from the Legislative Publica-
27 tions Account established in ORS 171.245, for services and supplies
28 connected with printing and distributing legislative publications and
29 the Oregon Revised Statutes, are not limited.

30 **“SECTION 13.** (1) There is appropriated to the Legislative Fiscal

1 **Officer, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General**
2 **Fund, the amount of \$4,301,378.**

3 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the**
4 **amount of \$3,779,805 is established for the biennium beginning July 1,**
5 **2017, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys**
6 **or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding**
7 **lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative**
8 **Fiscal Officer.**

9 **“SECTION 14. There is appropriated to the Legislative Policy and**
10 **Research Committee, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of**
11 **the General Fund, the amount of \$8,892,462.**

12 **“SECTION 15. There is appropriated to the Legislative Revenue Of-**
13 **ficer, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund,**
14 **the amount of \$3,036,432.**

15 **“SECTION 16. There is appropriated to the Commission on Indian**
16 **Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General**
17 **Fund, the amount of \$539,068.**

18 **“SECTION 17. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**
19 **the amount of \$7,035 is established for the biennium beginning July 1,**
20 **2017, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys**
21 **or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding**
22 **lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Commis-**
23 **sion on Indian Services.**

24 **“SECTION 18. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate**
25 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
26 **declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect July 1, 2017.”.**
