**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS TO
B-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 3355**

1 On page 5 of the printed B-engrossed bill, delete lines 32 through 45.

2 On page 6, delete lines 1 through 35 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 9.** ORS 675.110, as amended by section 13, chapter 104, Oregon
4 Laws 2017 (Enrolled House Bill 2319), is amended to read:

5 “675.110. In addition to the powers otherwise granted under ORS 675.010
6 to 675.150, the State Board of Psychologist Examiners has all powers neces-
7 sary or proper to:

8 “(1) Determine qualifications of applicants to practice psychology in this
9 state, prepare, conduct and grade examinations and license qualified appli-
10 cants who comply with the provisions of ORS 675.010 to 675.150 and the rules
11 of the board.

12 “(2) Grant or deny renewal of licenses and renew licenses that have
13 lapsed for nonpayment of the renewal fee, subject to the provisions of ORS
14 675.010 to 675.150.

15 “(3) Suspend or revoke licenses, subject to ORS 675.010 to 675.150.

16 “(4) Issue letters of reprimand and impose probationary periods with the
17 authority to restrict the scope of practice of a licensed psychologist or to
18 require practice under supervision.

19 “(5) Impose civil penalties as provided in ORS 675.070.

20 “(6) Restore licenses that have been suspended or revoked or voided by
21 nonpayment of the renewal fee.

1 “(7) Collect fees for application, examination and licensing of applicants,
2 for renewal of licenses and for issuance of limited permits and use the fees
3 to defray the expenses of the board as provided in ORS 675.140.

4 “(8) Collect a delinquent renewal fee for licenses renewed after the dead-
5 line for renewal but before the grace period for renewal has expired.

6 “(9) Investigate alleged violations of ORS 675.010 to 675.150.

7 “(10) Issue subpoenas for the attendance of witnesses, take testimony,
8 administer oaths or affirmations to witnesses, conduct hearings and require
9 the production of relevant documents in all proceedings pertaining to the
10 duties and powers of the board.

11 “(11) Enforce ORS 675.010 to 675.150 and exercise general supervision over
12 the practice of psychology in this state.

13 “(12) Adopt a common seal.

14 “(13) Formulate a code of professional conduct for the practice of psy-
15 chology giving particular consideration to the Ethical Standards of Psy-
16 chologists promulgated by the American Psychological Association.

17 “(14) Establish standards of service and training and educational quali-
18 fications for rendering ethical psychological services in this state, including
19 the formulation of standards for the issuance of licenses for areas of special
20 competence.

21 “(15) Formulate and enforce continuing education requirements for duly
22 licensed psychologists to ensure the highest quality of professional services
23 to the public.

24 “(16) Deny renewal of a license, or renewal of a license that has lapsed
25 for nonpayment of the renewal fee, unless the applicant completes, or pro-
26 vides documentation of previous completion of:

27 “(a) A pain management education program approved by the board and
28 developed in conjunction with the Pain Management Commission established
29 under ORS 413.570; or

30 “(b) An equivalent pain management education program, as determined

1 by the board.

2 “(17) For the purpose of requesting a state or nationwide criminal records
3 check under ORS 181A.195, require the fingerprints of a person who is:

4 “(a) Applying for a license that is issued by the board;

5 “(b) Applying for renewal of a license that is issued by the board; or

6 “(c) Under investigation by the board.

7 “(18) Prescribe, in consultation with the Oregon Board of Licensed Pro-
8 fessional Counselors and Therapists, the duties of the Director of the Mental
9 Health Regulatory Agency.

10 “**(19) Issue, suspend, revoke or deny certificates of prescriptive au-**
11 **thority under section 3 of this 2017 Act, and renew or deny renewal**
12 **of certificates of prescriptive authority.**

13 “[~~(19)~~] **(20)** Subject to the applicable provisions of ORS chapter 183, adopt
14 reasonable rules to carry out the provisions of ORS 675.010 to 675.150 **and**
15 **sections 1 to 7 of this 2017 Act.**”.
