**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 3078**

5 **“APPROPRIATIONS**

7 **“SECTION 7. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
8 **ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commis-**
9 **sion, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund,**
10 **the amount of \$7,000,000, to be deposited in the Justice Reinvestment**
11 **Account described in section 52, chapter 649, Oregon Laws 2013, and**
12 **expended for the purposes of carrying out the provisions of section 9**
13 **of this 2017 Act.**

14 **“SECTION 8. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
15 **ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Justice, for the**
16 **biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount**
17 **of \$1,000,000, for the Crime Victims’ Services Division and services for**
18 **victims of domestic and sexual violence.**

20 **“OREGON CRIMINAL JUSTICE COMMISSION**
21

1 **“SECTION 9. (1) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall**
2 **establish a program to award supplemental grant funds to counties for**
3 **downward departure prison diversion programs as part of the Justice**
4 **Reinvestment Program described in section 53, chapter 649, Oregon**
5 **Laws 2013. Notwithstanding sections 52 and 53 (1)(a), chapter 649,**
6 **Oregon Laws 2013, the commission shall use the moneys described in**
7 **section 7 of this 2017 Act for supplemental grant funds for downward**
8 **departure prison diversion programs in counties selected by the com-**
9 **mission to receive the supplemental grant funds. The commission shall**
10 **give preference to counties establishing downward departure prison**
11 **diversion programs on or after the effective date of this 2017 Act.**

12 **“(2) The commission shall monitor the downward departure prison**
13 **diversion programs described in subsection (1) of this section and**
14 **evaluate prison utilization by counties that receive the supplemental**
15 **grant funds. The commission shall annually report the evaluation**
16 **findings to the Joint Interim Committee on Ways and Means.**

17 **“SECTION 10. The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall study**
18 **the impact of this 2017 Act on prison utilization, recidivism and public**
19 **safety and report the results of the study to the interim committees**
20 **of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary, in the manner**
21 **provided in ORS 192.245, no later than February 1 of each year.**

25 **“SECTION 11. The unit captions used in this 2017 Act are provided**
26 **only for the convenience of the reader and do not become part of the**
27 **statutory law of this state or express any legislative intent in the**
28 **enactment of this 2017 Act.**

29 **“SECTION 12. (1) The amendments to ORS 137.717 and 421.168 by**
30 **sections 4 and 5 of this 2017 Act and the repeal of section 16, chapter**

1 **649, Oregon Laws 2013, by section 3 of this 2017 Act become operative**
2 **on January 1, 2018.**

3 **“(2) The amendments to ORS 137.717 by section 6 of this 2017 Act**
4 **become operative on July 1, 2023.**

5 **“SECTION 13. (1) The amendments to section 1, chapter 830, Oregon**
6 **Laws 2015, by section 2 of this 2017 Act apply to sentences imposed on**
7 **or after the effective date of this 2017 Act.**

8 **“(2) The amendments to ORS 137.717 and 421.168 by sections 4 and**
9 **5 of this 2017 Act apply to sentences imposed on or after January 1,**
10 **2018.**

11 **“(3) The amendments to ORS 137.717 by section 6 of this 2017 Act**
12 **apply to sentences imposed on or after July 1, 2023.**

13 **“SECTION 14. (1) Section 9 of this 2017 Act is repealed on July 1,**
14 **2023.**

15 **“(2) Section 10 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2028.**

17 **“EMERGENCY CLAUSE**

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19 **“SECTION 15. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate**
20 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**
21 **declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage.”.**

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
